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## 1. INTRODUCTION

### **BRIEF HISTORY:**

Guru Ravidas Ayurved University Punjab, Hoshiarpur was created with the promulgation of the Guru Ravidas Ayurved University Punjab Act, 2009 (Punjab Act No. 4 of 2010) by the Punjab Legislative Assembly. The University started functioning w.e.f. 01.02.2011. The main campus of the University is located in the foothills of Himalayas on Hoshiarpur-Una Road in 33 Acres of Land in village Kharkan (10 KM from Hoshiarpur city). The University has its own well-constructed Administrative Block in approximately 5 Acres of land. This University regulates the conduct of Undergraduate, Post-Graduate Ayurvedic, Homeopathic, Unani and Ph.D. teachings.

### **UNIVERSITY'S PRESENT STATUS:**

This University is one of its own kinds in North India. At present the University has total 20 affiliated colleges viz 16 Ayurvedic, 3 Homoeopathy and 1 Unani college. The P.G training in 3 M.D Ayurvedic colleges in various departments are being imparted under the affiliation of this University. The University has started Ph.D. in four departments of Ayurveda from the year 2020. It has about 6,000 registered students presently undergoing Undergraduate, Postgraduate and Ph.D. studies.

In addition to the academic activities, the University has also been providing health care services through its AYUSH OPD to the people of nearby villages.

The University has been striving to bring about major development in AYUSH and all basic, clinical and allied departments to pursue on education and research. Meritorious AYUSH faculties from all over the country are getting aspired to work in this University.

Admissions to various post graduate courses in the affiliated institutions of this University in the State of Punjab are made on merit basis of AIA-PGET-2025.

This prospectus is for admission to MD (Ayurveda) course available in Govt. Ayurvedic College, Patiala and Dayanand Ayurvedic College, Jalandhar for the session 2025.

## GENERAL INFORMATION

- 1.1 The Government of Punjab vide **Notification No. 2/109/2011/-5HB/1021 Dated 22.03.2022** has ordered the Guru Ravidas Ayurved University Punjab, to hold process of admission to MD (Ayurveda) courses in Govt Ayurved College, Patiala and Dayanand Ayurvedic College, Jalandhar.

## 3. RESERVATION

### Govt. Institute and Private Institute

The reservation of seats shall be as under:-

- i) SC/ST 25%
- ii) Backward Classes/OBC 10%
- iii) Physically Handicapped 5%
- iii) Economically Weaker Sections for Govt. college only (As per the notification of State Government and Govt. of India )

## 4. ELIGIBILITY

### MD(Ayurveda)

A person possessing the Bachelor Degree in Ayurved of a University or Board or Medical Institution specified in the second schedule to the Act notified by the Department of AYUSH, Govt. of India/CCIM/NCISM, shall be eligible for admission to the Postgraduate degree course.

**Note:** Please check Notification of Govt. of India, Ministry of AYUSH for instructions regarding last date of Compulsory Rotatory Internship.

### 5) FEE REQUIRED WITH ONLINE APPLICATION FORM:

- a) Rs. 2000/- to be deposited online by using Debit card or Credit card through University website i.e. [www.graupunjab.org](http://www.graupunjab.org) by due date and time for State Quota and All India Quota Candidates.
- c) **Fee once deposited in University account will not be refunded/adjusted.**

## 6. IMPORTANT INSTRUCTIONS TO FILL ONLINE ADMISSION APPLICATION FORM.

- i) Before applying, candidate should carefully read PROSPECTUS for eligibility conditions and other important conditions.
- ii) Only one application is to be submitted by a candidate. Submitting more than one Application by a candidate is liable to be rejected.
- iii) After filling online Application Form by candidate, University will issue a unique Registration Id. Registration Id (i.e. login Id will be provided to the candidate at his/her registered Mobile Number through SMS and email.
- v) Candidate should apply online on or before 25.09.2025 After this online application form will not be available at the University website and no request will be entertained in this regard.
- vi) Date should be filled in the format of dd/mm/yyyy i.e. date/month/year.
- viii) Registration Id is mandatory for further process, so keep it secret and won't disclose to any unknown person.

- x) How to upload photograph, Signature- You have to login by entering your Registration Id. The size of photograph, Signature, should not be more than 25KB respectively. Candidate may use third party software i.e. <http://www.shrinkpictures.com> to resize their photograph, Signature, before uploading.
- xi) Save Application: To get printout of your online Application Form you have to save your application. Once you save and proceed you will not be able to edit your application data, **so be ensured that you have entered correct data particularly check your Name, Date of Birth, categories etc. before save & proceed.**
- xii) Go to Registration part II. Thereafter make payment online. After successful payment, print out will be possible

## **7. MERIT LIST**

The University will prepare a list of the applicants for admission out of the successful candidates in the order of merit based on the AIA-PGET-2025 Rank and the provisions of the Punjab Government Notification No. **2/109/2011/-5HB/1021** Dated 22.03.2022 **and corrigendum issued from time to time and subsequent notifications in this regard** for the purpose of allotment of seats in the different courses/institutions through Online Mode only.

## **8. CHOICE OF THE SUBJECTS**

The candidate can apply for more than one specialty and he/she would be considered as per his/her merit on the basis of AIAPGET-2025.

(a) When two or more candidates have secured equal marks in the AIAPGET-2025 then inter-se-merit shall be determined as under:-

- i. Candidate with higher marks in qualifying examination.
- ii. Candidate older in age

## **9. ONLINE COUNSELLING**

1. Online counselling will be conducted through University Website and online counselling form will be made available on University website as per dates specified in Important Dates column.
2. In case of physical counselling, personal appearance of candidates is essential at the time of interview/counselling and exemptions from personal appearance may not be sought as it shall not be granted.
3. The candidates should read the eligibility conditions carefully and just exercising online option of college/ appearing in counselling does not entitle him/her for admission.
4. Eligibility conditions for admissions are as per Punjab Govt. Notification(s). The eligibility shall be determined by the Admission Committee at the time of counselling. Those who are not eligible as per Punjab Govt. notification will not be considered for admission. The candidates will appear in counselling at their own risk & responsibility.
5. The allotment of seat and college shall be made as per the choice of the candidate at the time of the counselling by the Admission Committee on the basis of the merit determined as per marks obtained by the candidate in AIAPGET -2025 and other terms and conditions contained in the Punjab Government Notification for admission to MD (Ayurveda) Course.
6. The candidates shall have to produce all the certificates/degrees/diplomas/ documents in original at the time of joining/admission in respective colleges or at the time of physical counselling.
7. The choice(s) of courses/ institutions shall be exercised by the candidate online.
8. **Checking/Verification of Original Certificate/Documents** :Allocation of seat is provisional subject to verification of original documents/checking of eligibility by the Principal of concerned Ayurvedic Colleges. After provisional allocation of seat, candidate shall have to report to the allocated college for getting challan form, verification of documents and checking of eligibility. It is the sole responsibility of the Principal to authenticate the eligibility of the provisionally allocated candidate before their joining/admission.
9. **Deposition of Annual Fee after provisional allocation** : Candidate will deposit tuition fee (as per Punjab Govt. notification) in the form of Demand Draft in the favour of Registrar Guru Ravidas Ayurved University, Payable at Hoshiarpur . Candidate will report for medical checkup and joining after submission of proof of fee deposition to the respective college within stipulated time period, failing which allocated seat will stand cancelled automatically without any intimation to the candidate.

In case of physical counselling candidate will have to deposit tuition fee as specified in the Punjab Govt. notification on the spot at the venue of counselling in the shape of Demand Draft in favour of



“Registrar, Guru Ravidas Ayurved University ” payable at “Hoshiarpur” failing which his/her provisional selection will be treated as cancelled without any intimation to the candidate.

## **10. IMPORTANT INSTRUCTIONS FOR CANDIDATE**

- a) In case any candidate is found to have furnished false information or certificate, etc, or is found to have withheld or concealed information in his/her application form he/she shall be debarred from admission.
- b) Any attempt by a candidate to influence, directly or indirectly, any person concerned with the admission will disqualify him/her.
- c) The claim for seat under reserved category/ categories should be made by filling appropriate column in the online Admission Application Form. The candidate must support this claim by attaching attested photocopies of the certificate(s) issued by the competent authority as per specimens given in Annexures to this prospectus. Original certificates shall have to be produced by the candidates at the time of Physical Counselling in the University.
- d) Specimens of various certificates to be submitted by the candidate are at Annexures- 1,2,3 & C.
- e) The Fee can be remitted online on University website through Debit Card or Credit Card. Fee shall not be accepted in any other mode. Candidature will be cancelled, who fails to deposit requisite fee.

## **12.Fee**

The Institute will charge the fee as per instructions issued by Punjab Government as well as Guru Ravidas Ayurved University Punjab, Hoshiarpur from time to time. The fee will be payable on annual basis.

**Subject: Admission to Post Graduate Ayurveda/Homeopathy courses in the State of Punjab for the Academic Session 2021-22 onwards.**

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1. The Governor of Punjab is pleased to notify the policy for admissions to AYUSH Post Graduate Courses in suppression of all the earlier notifications issued in this regard. This shall be applicable for admission to Post Graduate Courses in Ayurveda and Homeopathy in all participating and affiliated colleges in the State of Punjab for the Academic Session 2021-22 onwards.
2. The Governor of Punjab is further pleased to notify that all the institutions whether Government or Private, aided or unaided, minority or non-minority, shall be covered by this notification
3. All admissions to AYUSH PG courses –M.D. Ayurveda and M.D Homeopathy, in the Government and Private Institutions situated in the state of Punjab shall be based on the merit of all India AYUSH Post Graduate Entrance Test (AIA-PGET) which is conducted from time to time.
4. **Eligibility Criteria:** A candidate seeking admission to MD/MS Ayurveda/ Homeopathy Courses and will be eligible if he/she:
  - i. Has passed BAMS/BHMS examination from Recognized Universities from UGC and from the Institution recognized by the NCISM/Ministry of Ayush, New Delhi.
  - ii. Candidate should have completed satisfactorily one year compulsory Rotatory Internship from Institutions recognized by the NCISM/NCH/State Govt./Ministry of AYUSH for this purpose by 31.12.2021, as per Public Notice issued by NTA dating 17<sup>th</sup> August 2021 and consequent years as per AIAPGET eligibility criteria/ NCISM/NCH norms.
  - iii. The candidate should be registered with the Board of Ayurvedic and Unani System of Medicine, Punjab/ NCISM/NCH, New Delhi.

- iv. All candidates (General/SC/ST/OBC/Handicapped/EWS) desirous of seeking admissions in any category of seats should fulfill the minimum eligibility criteria/qualifications/qualifying criteria as prescribed in the information bulletin for AIAPGET-2021 issued by NTA for the Academic year 2021-22 and as per regulations of NCISM/NCH issued from time to time.
- v. No candidate who has failed to obtain the minimum eligibility marks (as specified in AIAPGET-2021) shall be eligible for admission to MD/MS (Ayurveda) Courses.

5. It is further notified that in the participating and affiliated colleges covered under this notification, 15% of the seats shall be under All India Merit Category of AIA-PGET, counseling for which is conducted by Department of AYUSH Government of India / National Commission for Indian Systems of Medicine. Remaining 85% seats shall be reserved for State Quota seats, where preference will be given to candidates who are residents of Punjab, even if they are lower in merit to the candidates from outside the State. The State quota seats may be filled by candidates from other states, only when no candidates from within the State is available after conducting of final counseling.

6. In the Government Ayurvedic College, Patiala, 25% of the State quota seats will be reserved for Ayurvedic Medical Officers (AMO) and remaining 75% will be for other categories, which will be allotted each year as per the roster maintained by the college based on the total seats approved by NCISM. Any vacant seats due to non-availability of eligible candidates under 25% in service category shall be offered to the eligible candidates under 75% quota and vice-versa.

6.1) For seats in each speciality (in service A.M.O's) under 25% quota:

- (a) These seats shall be open to the candidates who have completed five years of service. Date of eligibility shall be the last date of submission of application form. A Certificate regarding length of service as A.M.O. and NOC is required from the competent authority i.e. Director, Research & Medical Education, Punjab, SAS Nagar, Mohali /Director, Ayurveda Punjab, Chandigarh.
- (b) Ayurvedic Medical Officers selected under 25% quota will be sanctioned two years study leave and one year leave of kind due in terms of the policy of the Department of Health and Family welfare's order issued vide; Endorsement No. 2/4/2010-2Health-7/2126-81, dated 17/07/2014.
- (c) As per Punjab Govt. Notification Endst No. 2/109/2011-5SS3/8363-8367 dated 28.09.2021, the following will also apply:-  
AMOs admitted under 25% Quota at Government Ayurvedic College, Patiala will have to execute a Bond to serve the Punjab Government for five years after completing MD (Ayurveda). This Bond will be of Rs.15.00 Lakhs (Rupees



Fifteen Lakhs). In case, the person does not serve the Punjab Government for five year, after the completion of MD (Ayurveda) he/she will have to pay Rs.15.00 Lakhs to the Punjab Government.

6.2) For 75% seats in each specialty (open to all eligible Punjab residents):-

- (a) A candidate holding recognized basic qualification in Ayurvedic System of Medicine i.e. B.A.M.S/G.A.M.S who are residents of the State of Punjab must produce domicile certificate as per Department of Personnel (Personnel Policies Branch) vide letters No. 1/3/95-3PP11/9619, dated 6 June 1996 and No. 1/2/95/-3PP11/81 dated 1<sup>st</sup> January 1999, shall be eligible irrespective of the college from where they have graduated.

- (b) As per Punjab Govt. Notification Endst No. 2/109/2011-5SS3/8363-8367, dated 28.09.2021, the following will also apply:-

The persons admitted under 75% quota at Government Ayurvedic College, Patiala will have to execute a Bond to serve the Punjab Government for one year after completing MD (Ayurveda). In case, the person does not serve the Punjab Government for one year, he/she will have to pay Rs. 2.00 Lakhs (Rupees Two Lakhs) to the Punjab Government and he/she will also have to pay back the stipend to the Government.

- (c) Any candidate holding any employment either in public or private sector shall have to produce a "No Objection Certificate" from his/her employer.

7. **Determination of merit for admission :-**

- (a) Marks secured by the candidate in the All India AYUSH Post Graduate Entrance test (AIA-PGET)
- (b) There will be separate merit list for in service quota candidates i.e. 25% (AMO's) and a separate merit list for those who are not covered under the category of in service. The merit list for open and reserved category will be separate. The category filled in application form will be final. If any candidate has not filled the category then he/she will be considered in open category.
- (c) Where two or more candidates have equal marks in the AIA-PGET the merit of such candidates shall be determined in order of preference as under:-
- Candidates obtaining higher aggregate marks in B.A.M.S / G.A.M.S qualifying examination.
  - If marks in degree are same then the candidate older in age.

8. **Reservation (Government / Private) institutions:** The reservation for various categories in post Graduate admission will be as under:-


(a) Scheduled caste	25%
(b) Backward classes	10%
(c) Physically disabled	05%
(d) Economically Weaker Section (EWS)	10%
(In Govt. College Only)	

**For Scheduled Caste and Backward classes {(a & b) above}:**

(i) Candidates claiming benefits of reservation under S.C/B.C category will be required to produce a certificate from the competent authority as per instruction No.1/41/96/RC/1/11001-17 dated Chandigarh 5.12.1996 (for SC) and 1/41/93-RC/459 dated 17/1/1994 (For BC) issued by the Department of Welfare.

(ii) Candidate belonging to S.C/B.C will be eligible for admission as per their combined merit in AIA-PGET.

**For Physically disabled {(c) above};** The admission under this category shall be governed by the guidelines regarding specified Disabilities issued by the Government under the Rights of Person with Disabilities Act, 2016.

 **For EWS category {(d) above};** The candidates claiming admission under this category will be required to submit Income and Asset/ Income Disclosure Certificate valid for 2021-22 issued by the Competent Authority as per the instructions issued by the Govt. from time to time.

**Explanation:-** The following points shall be observed while granting above mentioned reservation:

- The reservation will be made college wise in each specialty separately subject to the availability of seats as per instructions of the Govt. of Punjab issued from time to time.
- A hundred point roster for all categories of seats quota wise/subject wise shall be maintained by Participating/Affiliated College(s) which will be verified by Guru Ravidas Ayurveda University, Hoshiarpur for allotment of seats as notified by NCISM/Govt. of Punjab.

**Note:** The candidate shall have to bring, in original, all the relevant certificates/ documents at the time of document verification without which admission to MD/MS (Ayurveda) Courses shall not be granted. Attested photocopies of certificates/documents will not



be considered valid for the purpose of counseling and the seat allocated to them shall be cancelled.

- i. A student who is already admitted to any PG Courses including PG Diploma course in any Institution is not eligible to apply till the completion of the course.
- ii. After commencement of PG courses if a candidate having joined the Institute but leaves the course after the three days prior to the last date of admission as prescribed by NCISM New Delhi, then he/she will be debarred for next five years from applying for admission to any PG Course in the State.
- iii. Candidate will have to submit a declaration to the effect that they have not abandoned the post graduate seat after opting for admission or after getting admitted in post graduate courses in the state of Punjab in the previous year.
- iv. Candidates who join the course will not be allowed to do private practice, in case of violation the candidature shall be cancelled and he/she will be debarred for 5 years.
- v. Concealment of facts or false declaration by the candidate shall lead to cancellation of admission of the candidate.
- vi. Personal appearance for counselling/interview is compulsory for all candidates applying for the post graduates admission. No separate interview letters will be issued.

12. **Choice of subject**

- The allotment of specialty shall be made on the basis of the merit obtained by the candidate in the AIA-PGET. This choice of the subject will be obtained by the candidate at the time of interview, which will be final and, if the candidate does not join, or leaves the course in between, he/she will be debarred for a period of five years for admission to P.G Course in the state of Punjab.
- Once admission is granted on the basis of choice of candidate, no change of specialty, category shall be allowed.
- For each specialty a waiting list will be prepared and if any vacancy subsequently arises, the same will be filled from within the waiting list.
- The last date for admission, filling up the vacancies and date for joining the college and the course shall be fixed by Guru Ravidas Ayurved University, Hoshiarpur in terms of the notification issued by NCISM from time to time.





- (i) Stipend to the students admitted in Government Ayurvedic College, Patiala will be as per the decision of the Government from time to time.
  - (ii) Stipend to the candidates admitted in private colleges will be as decided by the Government separately.

**13.4 Fee in Homoeopathic college will be as under:-**

The institute will charge fee of Rs 1,25,000/- per annum. The fee will be payable on annual basis.

**14.** The schedule for commencement of classes, cut-off date for admission, joining date to college etc. shall be in accordance with the schedule notified by the National Commission for Indian System of Medicine (NCISM) and National Council of Homoeopathy (NCH) from time to time.

**15.** In case if there is any vacancy occurs after the first round of counseling due to any reason, such seats will be filled up during the second round of counselling.

- a) Fresh registration shall be allowed for participating in the second round. Fresh candidates will have to register themselves for the admission. The candidates are advised to regularly visit the website of Guru Ravidas Ayurveda University, Hoshiarpur for updates.
- b) The candidates, who have already registered themselves for first round and wish to participate in the second round, shall not be required to register again. However, they shall have to give their willingness/option to participate in the second round of counselling by submitting the previous form again with the same registration number, the security fee and change of choices if any.

- c) The candidate who wishes to participate in the 2nd round of PG Counseling shall be required to submit Security Fee as per GRAU, Hoshiarpur.
- d) The fresh candidates will also have to submit registration fee as per GRAU, Hoshiarpur. If a candidate does not deposit the requisite amount then he/she shall not be eligible to participate in the 2nd round of Counseling.
- e) The candidate who have been allotted seat in the first round shall have a right to retain already allotted seat and this shall be changed only if he/she gets an updated and opted seat during second round. However, the candidates who wish to participate in the 2<sup>nd</sup> round of online counselling will have to submit their preferences afresh again. Candidates, who have been allotted, seat in first round should give the fresh choices in order of preferences for the College/Course/Specialty in which they wish to upgrade themselves.





**A. DIRECTIVE FOR COUNSELING AUTHORITIES (State / UT)**

**I. Common Directives for State/UT Counseling and Admissions**

**Eligibility Criteria to Participate in the Counseling:-**

1. Colleges/Institute who have received permission from the Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine (MARBISM)/National Commission for Indian System of Medicine (NCISM) or Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Homoeopathy (MARBH)/National Commission for Homoeopathy (NCH), New Delhi, for admission to ASU&H-PG courses for the academic session 2025-2026 shall only be eligible to participate in the counseling process.

**Seat Matrix (AIQ & State/ UT Quota):-**

2. The seat matrix for admission in the 'State/UT Government, Government-aided institutions, and Private Institutions' shall be fifteen percent (15%) for All-India Quota and eighty-five percent (85%) for State/Union Territory Quota as specified in the NCISM and NCH Regulations in force at the time of admission.

**Provided that-**

- i. the AIQ for the purpose of admission in all the Deemed Universities (both Government and Private - established under Central Act), shall be hundred percent;
  - ii. the University and institute, which are already having more than fifteen percent All-India Quota seats, shall continue to maintain that quota;
  - iii. five per cent. of the annual sanctioned intake capacity in Government and Government-aided institutions shall be filled up by candidate with specified disability in accordance with the provisions of the Rights of Persons with Disabilities Act, 2016 (49 of 2016) and based on the merit list of AIAPGET-2025.
3. For State/UT quota (85%), the seat matrix for Government, Management, NRI quota etc., shall be as per respective State/UT policy; however, all admissions in all quotas (except foreign nationals) shall be through counseling conducted by State/UT counseling authority.
4. The Management seats under the State/UT Quota in Private Institutions shall be treated as domicile-free.

**Reservation:-**

5. Category-wise reservation of seats shall be as per Central or State or UT Reservation Policy, as the case may be.
6. Reservation for allotment of 15% AIQ-PG seats in Private ASU &H Institutes:-All AIQ- PG seats of Private ASU & H Institutes are open in nature (all category candidates are eligible).

However, as mentioned in relevant regulations, the relaxation in qualifying criteria may be provided category-wise.



**Counseling schedule:**

7. Central and State/UT counseling authorities shall prepare the counseling schedule for the A.Y.2025-2026 in concurrence with the schedule specified by NCISM/ NCH as given below:

Date of commencement of the PG Programs of Ayurveda, Unani, Siddha and Homoeopathy: 7 November 2025

A penalty of ₹1,00,000 (Rupees One Lakh) per day shall be levied by the NCISM/NCH on colleges/institutes for failure to submit the admission data within 25th November, 2025 (On or Before 6 PM).

- ❖ It has been observed in past academic year that the schedule of State/UT Ayush Counseling is delayed as a result of which candidate find difficulties in making choice of college for admission/ becoming ineligible for Ayush Counseling/forfeiture of Security money thus inviting multiple grievances and litigations. In order to avoid it State/UT-Counseling authority/University need to begin their State/UT Ayush Counseling as per schedule specified.
- ❖ State/UT Ayush Counseling authority shall provide the data of vacant seat on the last day of reporting of every round to Central Govt. (AACCC, NCISM) to take analytical/calculative decision regarding counseling.

#### Counseling and Admissions:-

1. All sanctioned/permitted seats by the Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine (MARBISM)/NCISM/ Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Homoeopathy (MARBH)/ NCH/ Government of India, irrespective of categories /reservations, are to be filled only through online counseling, i.e., Central /State/UT counseling as the case may be (except foreign nationals).
2. Ayush Admissions Central Counseling Committee (AACCC), NCISM will conduct "AIQ-PG Online Counseling" for admission to AIQ (15%) seats under State-UT Govt./Govt. Aided Colleges/ Central/Deemed Universities (Established under Central Act) and National Institutes of ASU&H streams.
3. The State/UT Counseling authorities shall conduct counseling for admission in 15% of AIQ-PG seats under Private ASU&H colleges/institutes/State Universities (other than Deemed Universities established under the Central Act). Further, State/UT Counseling shall be conducted in adherence to guidelines/schedule provided by NCISM/NCH to avoid the overlapping of the Schedule of AACCC counseling and State/UT counseling
4. For State/UT (85%) Quota, the seat matrix for Government Quota, Management Quota, NRI Quota etc., shall be as per respective State and UT policy; however, all admissions in all quotas (except foreign nationals) shall be through online counseling conducted by State/UT counseling authority.
5. Seat allotment in any category shall be as per inter-se-merit.
6. No candidate who has failed to obtain the minimum eligibility marks in AIAPGET – 2025 shall be admitted to Postgraduate courses for the academic year 2025-26.
7. Qualification Criterion: (As per the ASU & H-PG Regulations in force at the time of admission)
  - a) *National Commission for Indian System of Medicine (Minimum Essential Standards, Assessment and Rating for Postgraduate Institutions and Minimum Standards for Postgraduate Education in Ayurveda) Regulations, 2024*

- b) *National Commission for Indian System of Medicine (Minimum Essential Standards, Assessment and Rating for Postgraduate Institutions and Minimum Standards of Postgraduate Siddha Education) Regulations, 2024*
- c) *National Commission for Indian System of Medicine (Minimum Essential Standards, Assessment and Rating for Postgraduate Institutions and Minimum Standards of Postgraduate Unani Education) Regulations, 2024*
- d) *Homoeopathy Post-Graduate Degree Course-Doctor of Medicine in Homoeopathy Regulations, 2024*

**For admission to ASU&H - PG Courses:**

8. Passing marks for eligibility in admission to ASU&H- PG courses should be as per the ASU&H- PG regulations and should be followed strictly. The details of qualifications for different categories are as follows:
  - i. Candidates must possess BAMS/BUMS/ BSMS/ BHMS/Graded BHMS (after Diploma Course in Homoeopathy of not less than four year's duration) Degree or Provisional degree certificate recognized as per the provisions of the IMCC 1970/HCC 1973/ NCISM 2020 Act /NCH 2020 Act. The candidate needs to produce a permanent Registration at the time of commencement of the course. The counseling authority should obtain an undertaking at the time of reporting from the candidate that he/she shall submit the permanent registration before/ at the time of commencement of the course issued by the CCIM/NCISM/CCH/NCH/State Medicine Board, and must have completed a satisfactorily one- year compulsory rotating internship by 31<sup>st</sup> July 2025 for ASU streams and 31<sup>st</sup> August, 2025 for Homoeopathy stream as per the NCISM/NCH notification.(for the academic year 2025-26 only)
  - ii. In order to be eligible for admission to postgraduate courses for an academic year, it shall be necessary for a candidate to obtain minimum of marks at 50<sup>th</sup> percentile in the All India Ayush Post Graduate Entrance Test, 2025 (AIAPGET-2025).

Provided that in respect of-

- (a) candidates belonging to the Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes and Other Backward Classes, the minimum marks shall be at 40<sup>th</sup> percentile;
  - (b) candidates with benchmark disabilities specified under the Rights of Persons with Disabilities Act, 2016 (49 of 2016), the minimum marks shall be at 45<sup>th</sup> percentile for the General Category and 40<sup>th</sup> percentile for the Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes and Other Backward Classes.
- iii. No upper age limit is specified for admission to ASU&H-PG Courses.
9. No Authority or Institution shall admit any candidate to the Postgraduate courses in contravention of the criteria or procedure in respect of admissions, and any admissions made in contravention shall be cancelled by the NCISM/NCH.
  10. Any admissions made beyond/over and above the intake capacity sanctioned/permitted by MARBISM/NCISM/MARBH/NCH for the said academic session shall not be approved.
  11. Vide Court order dated 30.11.2023 in SCA No. 19485/2023 at High Court of Gujarat, the Court has observed that the authority has not provided any guidelines to fill the seats that remain vacant after the Stray Vacancy Round (SVR). To comply with the direction of the Court, it is requested to all Central/State/UT counseling Authorities to conduct sufficient phase-wise allotments in stray vacancy round to fill the seats, considering the number of available candidates in the Central/State/UT merit list, whichever is applicable, and availability of vacant seats till that gets filled within the cut-off date of admission as notified by NCISM/NCH. The guidelines for State/UT counseling Authorities to conduct the SVR are as follows:



- a) Publication of non-reported /not-filled seats after R-3 on the State /UT counseling portal (wide publicity by any other means may also be adopted)
  - b) Publication of ineligible list of candidates who have not complied with the Central /State /UT counseling rules / norms
  - c) Registration facility for non-registered candidates on the State/UT counseling portal
  - d) Choice filling facility, as applicable.
  - e) Allotment of seats based on merit and preferences of the candidates.
  - f) Publication of result on the State/UT counseling portal
  - g) Reporting at the allotted institute
12. After the first phase of allotment in SVR, publish the non-reported/not-filled seats on the State/UT counseling portal and conduct subsequent rounds to fill the vacant seats, if any, as per the procedure mentioned in the first phase allotment considering the availability of candidates. Eligible non-registered candidates shall be provided the registration facility for all rounds of SVR; however, the whole process of SVR allotment be completed within the time frame, and no admission after the cut-off date decided by NCISM/NCH shall be allowed/approved. The schedule for the last round of SVR shall be conducted in such a way that the allotted candidates will get sufficient time to report to the allotted institute before the cut-off date of admission decided by NCISM/NCH.
  13. It has been observed in past few years, that different Hon'ble Courts use to grant relief to the candidates taking offline admission just before cut-off date of admission on the ground of technical glitch in State/UT-Ayush Counseling portal. Therefore, State/UT-Ayush Counseling Authorities portal must be technically sound for seamless online counseling and admissions of eligible candidates, till the process of admissions last.
  14. **There shall not be any institute-level counseling through any mode. Any admissions made at the institute level shall not be approved by the NCISM/NCH/Concerned University and the institute shall be penalised as per the provision laid down under the sub-section (1)(a)(f) of section 28 of NCISM Act 2020/NCH Act 2020.**
  15. There shall not be any offline admission or admission without counseling (Central/State/UT), and any admissions in contravention of this shall not be approved.
  16. Admission made in violation of the Central Government / NCISM / NCH directives will be treated as invalid, and action will be initiated under the NCISM Act, 2020 / NCH Act,2020.
  17. Institutes will be held responsible in case students face hardship due to admission irregularities such as offline admissions, admission without counseling, and admission beyond sanctioned intake capacity. In such case, students shall be discharged from the course and institution, and the institute will be subjected to face consequences as per the provision laid down under the sub-section (1)(a)(f) of section 28; sub-section (3) of section 10 of NCISM Act 2020/NCH Act 2020, and the person responsible will be prosecuted as per the section of IPC/BNS concerned, whichever is applicable.
  18. **Admissions shall not be approved by any means after the cut-off date and time for admission as specified by NCISM/NCH.**
  19. No authority has the power to extend or modify the cut-off date of admission specified by NCISM/NCH, and such admissions shall not be approved.
  20. No authority has the power to increase the intake capacity for admission into PG courses in ASU&H colleges sanctioned by MARBISM/MARBH/NCISM/NCH.
  21. State/UT Counseling Authorities may direct ASU&H colleges/institutes to ensure the

eligibility of the candidate as specified in the NCISM and NCH Regulations in force at the time of admission by proper scrutiny of the relevant original certificates and documents at the time of admission.

22. AACCC will circulate the list of ineligible candidates to the State/UT counseling Authority during the 3<sup>rd</sup> & Stray Vacancy Round (SVR-I & II) of AACCC-PG counseling to prevent them from participating in the State/UT counseling. **State/UT Counseling Authorities need to ensure that such candidates have not been allotted any seat through any rounds of State/UT counseling for admission in ASU&H-PG courses.**
23. ASU&H colleges/institutes should ensure that the candidates, allotted seats through Central/State/UT counseling as the case may be, submit the original Compulsory Rotatory Internship completion certificate at the time of reporting to the allotted institutes. The cut-off date for completion of the internship towards determination of eligibility for appearing in AIAPGET-2025 shall be **31<sup>st</sup> July 2025 for ASU Streams and 31<sup>st</sup> August, 2025 for Homoeopathy stream** (for A.Y.2025-26 only).
24. State/UT Counseling Authorities may direct ASU&H colleges/institutes to ensure the authenticity and correctness of the details of admitted students before completing the admission procedures. Further, the ASU&H colleges/institutes should be instructed not to allow admissions without original documents. No modifications/ corrections after the cut-off date and time of admission as specified by NCISM/NCH shall be entertained.
25. The State/UT Counseling authorities have to submit a list of admitted students (i.e. college-wise consolidated list of admitted students through all rounds of counseling) to NCISM/NCH within specified date as mentioned in the schedule from the cut-off date of admission in the format and in the manner as prescribed by NCISM/NCH.
26. All State/UT Counseling Authorities are requested to see the website of AACCC (<https://aaccc.gov.in>), from time to time for AACCC- PG counseling scheme & FAQs, Schedule and any updates/notices uploaded regarding All India Quota-ASU&H-PG counseling for the A.Y 2025-26.
27. In past few years, the student helpline center of AACCC, receive lot of grievances from candidates participating in State/UT-Ayush Counseling that is outside the purview of Central Ayush Counseling Authority. Therefore, State/UT Counseling Authority must run an effective Query Redressal System to facilitate the counseling and admission process of UG courses and provide the email ID & Phone no of the same on the State/UT Counseling Authority's website.
28. The State / UT counseling for ASU&H-PG Courses shall be started only after Central Counseling has commenced, in accordance with the schedule issued by NCISM/NCH.
29. **State Ayush Admissions Reporting Portal:** All State/UT counseling Authorities need to upload the round-wise data on admissions made through State/UT counseling under 85% of State/UT Quota seats of State-UT Govt./Govt. Aided colleges and 100% seats of Private Institutions of Ayurveda, Siddha, Unani and Homoeopathy streams all over the Country on the interphase of the AACCC-PG portal.

**Determination of fees and other charges in case of ASU& H colleges/ institutes under NCISM/ NCH:-**

30. The fee for 50 percentage (50%) of total sanctioned/permitted seats in Private ASU&H medical colleges/institutes and deemed universities which are governed under the NCISM Act, 2020/NCH Act,2020, is to be determined by Fee fixation/Regulatory Committee (FRC) of the respective State/UT/Deemed University as per the guidelines for "Determination of

implemented from the A.Y 2022-23 onwards.

**Tuition fee.-**

31. All State/UT Counseling authorities are requested to ensure that the institutes only charge the tuition fee, as laid down and fixed by respective governing or fee fixation committees as applicable, in each academic session. No tuition fee shall be charged for an extended study duration in case of failing examinations or other reasons.
32. All Central/State/UT Counseling authorities are requested to ensure that the college should display tuition fees, hostel fees, and other fees, if any, on the institute's website and the Institute profile while uploading to the Central/State/UT counseling Portal. The same is to be charged from the student at the time of admission. No other charges other than the displayed fees should be charged/ collected.

**II. Directives for State/UT counseling for admission in 15% of AIQ-PG seats under Private ASU&H colleges/ institutes/ Private State Universities (other than Deemed Universities established under the Central Act)**

1. The State/UT Counseling authorities shall conduct counseling for 15% of AIQ-PG seats under Private ASU&H colleges/institutes/Private State Universities (other than Deemed Universities established under the Central Act).
2. The State/UT Counseling Authorities have to conduct counseling for admission in 15% of AIQ-PG seats under Private ASU&H colleges/institutes/ State Universities (other than Deemed Universities established under Central Act) in adherence with guidelines/schedule provided by NCISM/NCH to avoid the overlapping of the schedule of AACCC counseling and State or UT counseling
3. The State/UT counseling authorities shall conduct 03 Rounds of counseling for admission in 15% All India Quota (AIQ) PG seats of Private ASU&H Institutes/Private State Universities (other than Deemed Universities established under the Central Act). The AIQ seats that remain vacant after the second round of State/UT counseling may be converted to the State/UT quota seats, and the same shall be filled up in further rounds as per State Government norms/ rules.
4. The State/UT counseling authorities should give wider publicity among AIAPGET-2025 qualified ASU&H-PG aspirants regarding the registration process of counseling & provide sufficient time for registration before each round of counseling for admission in AIQ-PG seats of Private ASU&H Institutes.
5. The State/UT may decide on an all-inclusive application Cost/Non-refundable Registration Fee for counseling for admission in ASU&H-PG seats for all category students. **However, the maximum ceiling limit for this fee will be Rs 2000/-.**
6. State/UT may decide on refundable security money, which will be refunded to candidates after joining the allotted college or if the candidate did not get any seat during counseling. **However, the maximum ceiling limit for this fee will be Rs. 50,000/- for PG seats.**
7. The Security money will be forfeited if a candidate does not join the Round-2 allotted seat or surrender/withdraw the seat Round-2 joined seat based on the candidate's request. Further, the Security money will also be forfeited if the Round-2 allotted seat is cancelled due to any unforeseen reason from the candidate's end. For example, the candidate gives wrong information at the time of registration based on which a seat may be allotted and later cancelled by the Admission Authorities at the time of reporting or fails to produce the required original documents at the time of admission(within the stipulated time).

8. Make a provision for candidates admitted in the All India Quota Private (PG) seats during Round 2 of State/UT-PG counseling to withdraw/surrender their admitted seats by forfeiting security money only during a specific time period specified by State/UT authority. Further, State/UT authorities can decide the time period to withdraw/surrender the admitted seat of Round-2 with forfeiture as per their counseling schedule. After the said period, candidates will not be allowed to withdraw/surrender their Round-2 admitted seats. If they do so, they will be ineligible for any further Ayush counseling conducted by Central/State/UT as decided by the State/UT counseling Authorities
9. **The admission on any other reserved quota seats in State shall be through Counseling authority designated by Central/State/UT Govt. only. Admissions done through any committee/local body/private organization members shall not be approved by NCISM/NCH.**
  10. No domicile certificate is required for allotment of AIQ- PG seats of Private ASU & H Institutes.
11. For PwD candidates, the PwD certificate should be as per the regulation issued by Central Government and notified by the NCISM/NCH.
12. As per the Central Government Nominated- PG counseling guidelines for the A. Y 2025-26, issued by the Ministry of Ayush, after the admission process of candidates in the CGN quota, the information regarding vacant seats, if any, shall be forwarded to AACCC for further necessary action. The AACCC will apply centrally approved reservation roster on the vacant seats as per the extant policy/rules and allot these seats to AIAPGET-2025 qualified candidates based on merit and preference submitted by them on the AACCC-PG portal (<https://aaccc.gov.in>).

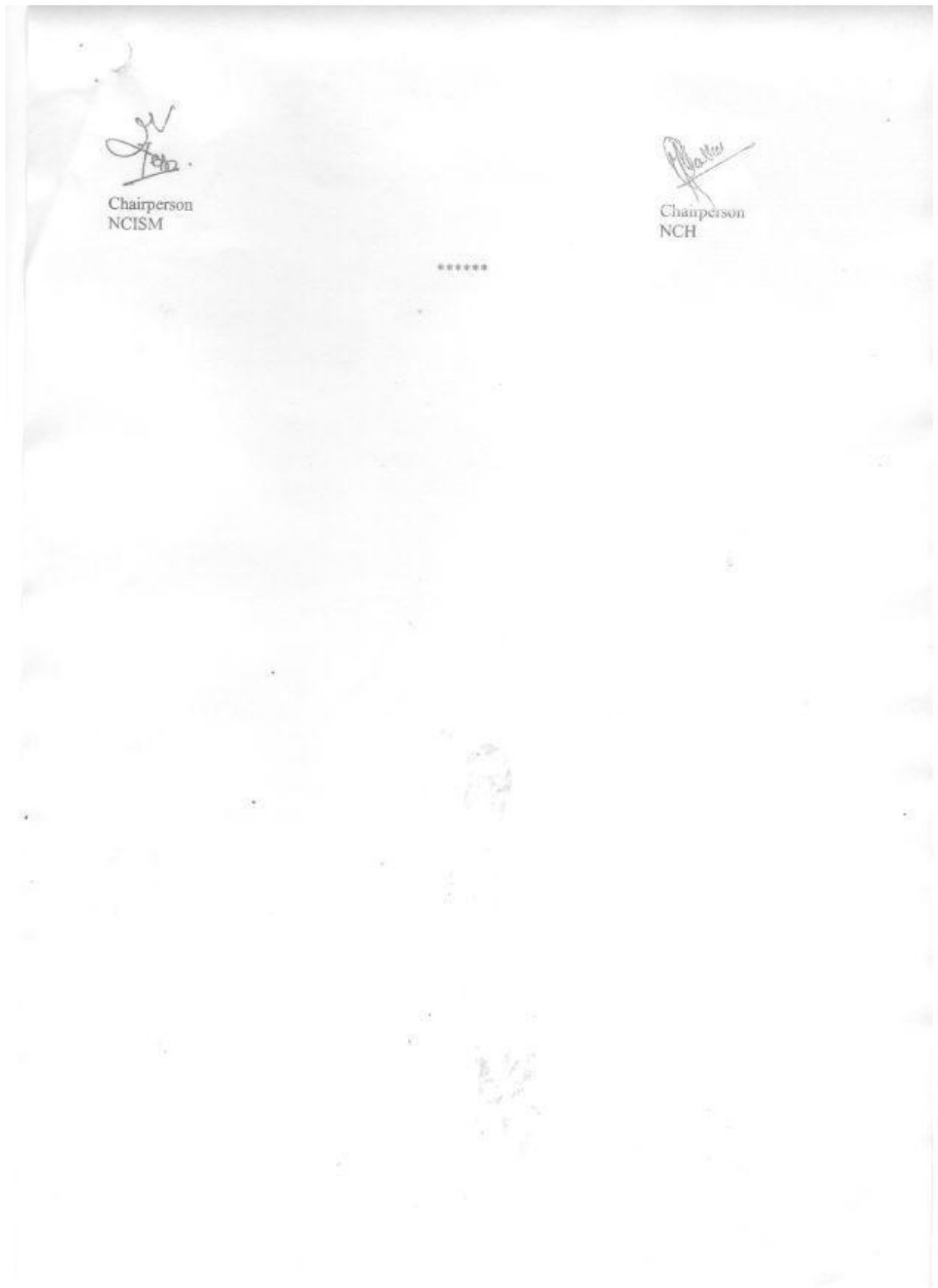
**B. DIRECTIVES FOR UNIVERSITIES:**

1. In case of admission in Ayurveda, Siddha, Unani, and Homoeopathy courses, the University shall approve the admissions made by any college/institute with proper permission from the MARBISM/MARBH/NCISM/NCH for the academic session 2025-2026.
2. The University shall not approve the admissions made by the colleges/institutes under the following conditions:
  - Offline admissions
  - Admissions without counseling (Central/State/UT);
  - Admissions after the cut-off-date,
  - Admissions beyond sanctioned intake capacity.
  - Admissions without original mandatory documents
3. There shall not be any institute-level counseling through any mode. Any admissions made at the institute level shall not be approved by the NCISM/NCH/Concerned University, and the institute shall be penalised as per the provision laid down under sub-section (1)(a)(f) of section 28 of the NCISM Act 2020/NCH Act 2020.

**C. DIRECTIVES FOR COLLEGES / INSTITUTES:**

1. No candidate who has failed to obtain the minimum eligibility marks in AIAPGET – 2025 shall be admitted to Postgraduate courses, for the academic year 2025-26.
2. There shall not be any institute-level counseling through any mode. Any admissions made at the institute level shall not be approved by the NCISM/NCH/ Concerned University. Any

- such admissions made in contravention to the directives/guidelines issued by the NCISM/NCH, the institute shall be penalised as per the provision laid down under the sub-section (1)(a)(f) of section 28 of NCISM Act 2020/NCH Act 2020.
3. There shall not be any offline admission or admission without counseling (Central/State/UT), or admission beyond sanctioned intake capacity, and any admissions in contravention of this shall not be approved.
  4. Admission made in violation of the NCISM / NCH directives will be treated as invalid, and action will be initiated under the NCISM Act,2020/NCH Act, 2020
  5. Institutes will be held responsible in case students face hardship due to admission irregularities such as offline admissions, admission without counseling, and admission beyond sanctioned intake capacity etc. In such cases, students shall be discharged from the course and institution. The institute will be subjected to face consequences as per the provision laid down under sub-section (1)(a)(f) of section 28 of NCISM Act 2020/NCH Act 2020. The persons responsible will be prosecuted as per the section of IPC/BNS concerned, whichever is applicable.
  6. ASU&H colleges/institutes should ensure the candidate's eligibility as laid down in respective regulations as mentioned in these guidelines and proper scrutiny of the relevant original certificates and documents at the time of admission.
  7. It is requested that all participating institutes visit Central (AACCC-PG portal: <https://aaccc.gov.in> and the concerned State/UT counseling portal from time to time for counseling scheme & FAQs, Schedule and any updates/notices regarding PG counseling 2025-26.
  8. The Principal/AACCC-PG Nodal Officer of the college should check their mails regularly, to receive all communications made by AACCC with the participating college and to act accordingly.
  9. ASU & H colleges/ institutes should ensure the authenticity and correctness of the details of admitted students before completing admission procedures. No modifications/ corrections after the cut-off date and time of admission as specified by NCISM/NCH shall be entertained.
  10. The colleges should follow the Central/State/UT counseling schedule and upload the details of admitted students and non-reported/vacant seats, if any, for each round on the concerned counseling authority portal, even on holidays.
  11. The list of all admitted students with all details shall be uploaded and submitted to NCISM/NCH in the format prescribed by NCISM/NCH **on or before 6 pm on the cut-off date (15<sup>th</sup> December 2025)** for admission as specified by NCISM/NCH.
  12. The college shall display tuition fees, hostel fees, and other fees, if any, on the institute's website and on the Institute profile while uploading on the Central/State/UT counseling portal as applicable. The same is to be charged from the student at the time of admission. No other charges other than the displayed fees should be collected from the candidates.
  13. To accommodate the maximum number of candidates and minimise the number of non-reported/vacant seats in colleges, the provision of multiple phase allotment in the Stray Vacancy round (*Choice filling is available during SVR-I and no repeated choice filling afterwards*) may be followed by State/UT Ayush counseling authorities.

1. Ayush Admissions Central Counseling Committee (AACCC), NCISM will conduct "AIQ-PG Online Counseling" for admission in Govt. / Govt. Aided Colleges/ National Institutes/ Central & Deemed Universities (Government and Private- established under Central Act) of ASU&H streams.
2. Qualification Criterion: (As per the ASU&H- PG Regulations in force at the time of admission)
  - a. ***National Commission for Indian System of Medicine (Minimum Essential Standards, Assessment and Rating for Postgraduate Institutions and Minimum Standards for Postgraduate Education in Ayurveda) Regulations, 2024.***
  - b. ***National Commission for Indian System of Medicine (Minimum Essential Standards, Assessment and Rating for Postgraduate Institutions and Minimum Standards of Postgraduate Siddha Education) Regulations, 2024.***
  - c. ***National Commission for Indian System of Medicine (Minimum Essential Standards, Assessment and Rating for Postgraduate Institutions and Minimum Standards of Postgraduate Unani Education) Regulations, 2024***

3. Passing marks for eligibility in admission to ASU&H-PG courses should be as per the ASU&H-PG regulations and should be followed strictly. The details of qualifications for different categories are as follows:
  - i. Candidates must possess BAMS/ BSMS/ BUMS/ BHMS/Graded BHMS (after Diploma Course in Homoeopathy of not less than four year's duration) Degree or Provisional degree certificate recognized as per the provisions of the IMCC 1970/HCC 1973/ NCISM 2020 Act /NCH 2020 Act and possess permanent or provisional registration certificate issued by the CCIM/NCISM/CCH//NCH/State/UTs Board, and must have completed a satisfactorily one-year compulsory rotating internship as per the NCISM/NCH notification. (for the academic year 2025-26 only)
  - ii. In order to be eligible for admission to postgraduate courses for an Academic year, it shall be necessary for a candidate to obtain a minimum of marks at 50<sup>th</sup> percentile in the All India Ayush Post Graduate Entrance Test, 2025 (AIAPGET-2025).

Provided that in respect of-

(a) candidates belonging to the Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes and Other Backward Classes, the minimum marks shall be at 40th percentile;

(b) candidates with benchmark disabilities specified under the Rights of Persons with Disabilities Act, 2016 (49 of 2016), the minimum marks shall be at 45th percentile for the General Category and 40th percentile for the Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes and Other Backward Classes.

**No upper age limit is specified for admission to ASU&H-PG Courses.**

4. The colleges are requested to follow the instructions before updating the seat matrix as below-

- a. Ensure the number of Total seats, AIQ seats, and State quota seats based on the permission letter issued by NCISM/NCH for the academic year 2025-26 and also in consultation with the respective State/UT counseling Authorities.
- b. AIQ-PG seats may be calculated as follows-

In the case of Govt./Govt. Aided colleges, 15% of the total permitted intake capacity of PG course/s shall be treated as AIQ seats. If the percentage of permitted intake capacity comes in decimal, then it shall be counted as below-

- If the decimal comes below 0.50, it will be considered as the nearest next lower digit. If it comes equal to or exceeds 0.50, it will be considered as the nearest next upper digit.

- For Example: if the total permitted intake capacity of PG course/s of a college is 03, then the AIQ for the same is 0.45, and it may be treated as zero. If the total permitted intake capacity of PG course/s of the college is 04, then the AIQ for the same is 0.60, and it may be treated as 01)

5. ASU & H institutes are requested to fill the seat matrix on a rotational basis of Ayurveda/Siddha/Unani/Homoeopathy PG courses in continuation to the previous academic year 2024-25.

- For example, an institute has PG in 04 subjects, say A,B,C,D and the no. of AIQ-PG seats out of the total permitted intake capacity is 03: if the seat matrix filled by the institute in the last year ( 2024-25 ) in 03 subjects i.e. A,B,C then for the current year (2025-26), the college must fill AIQ-PG seats on rotational basis beginning from D subject i.e. D,A,B. ( *PG subject sequence in alphabetical order under ASU & H stream attached herewith for ready reference* )

6. The colleges should follow the AACCC-PG counseling schedule/Notices uploaded on the AACCC-PG portal. It is further instructed to facilitate the admission/reporting of students who have been allotted seats during the 1<sup>st</sup> /2<sup>nd</sup> /3<sup>rd</sup> Round and Stray Vacancy Round (*SVR-I & SVR-II*) of AACCC-PG counseling, even on holidays, if necessary.
7. It is strictly instructed that all admissions shall be made through online mode only; the AACCC, will not consider offline admissions in any circumstances.
8. All cancellations/relieving and resignations (if allowed) will be made through online mode only; no offline cancellations/ relieving/resignation of the seat is permitted.
9. Admission made in violation of the Central Government / NCISM / NCH directives will be treated as invalid, and action will be initiated under the NCISM Act, 2020 / NCH Act, 2020
10. ASU&H colleges/institutes should ensure the candidate's eligibility as laid down in relevant PG-ASU&H regulations for admissions in ASU&H-PG courses by proper scrutiny of the relevant original certificates and documents at the time of admission.
11. ASU&H colleges/institutes should ensure the authenticity and correctness of the details of admitted students before completing admission procedures. No modifications/ corrections after the cut- off date and time of admission as specified by NCISM/NCH shall be entertained.
12. ASU & H colleges/institutes should ensure that no fees (submitted at the time of admission by the candidate) will be deducted by the college on re-allocation/up gradation of a seat from 1<sup>st</sup>/2<sup>nd</sup> to 2<sup>nd</sup>/3<sup>rd</sup> round of AACCC-PG Counseling.
13. Institutes will appoint a Nodal Officer well conversant with the online counseling & reporting/admission process of allotted candidates through AACCC-PG Counseling and effectively coordinate with AACCC, when required. (For example, fill in the correct information on the institute profile & seat matrix, timely answer the emails sent by AACCC & send the reporting status after every round of counseling, etc). Nodal officers must visit the AACCC-PG portal ([www.aaccc.gov.in](http://www.aaccc.gov.in)) regularly for any updates/notices regarding PG counseling for the A.Y 2025-26.
14. Institutes will be held responsible if students face hardship due to admission irregularities (offline admissions, admission without counseling, and admission beyond sanctioned intake capacity). In such cases, students shall be discharged from the course and institution, and the institute will be penalised as per the provision laid down under the sub-section (1)(a)&(f) of section 28 and sub-

section (3) of section 10 of NCISM Act 2020/NCH Act. The persons responsible will be prosecuted as per the section of IPC/BNS concerned.

15. College authority shall inform the NCISM via E-mail ID (counseling-ayush@gov.in) regarding any specific provisions for seat allotment, such as college only for girls/minority quota, etc.
16. It is requested that all State/UT Counseling Authorities conduct counseling for admission in PG(MD/MS) Courses of ASU&H colleges/institutes /Private State Universities (other than Deemed Universities under the Central Act) in adherence with guidelines /schedule provided by the AACCC, NCISM/NCH to avoid the overlapping of the Schedule of AACCC-PG counseling and State/UT-PG counseling.
17. ASU & H colleges/ institutes should ensure that the fee structure for All India Quota (AIQ) – PG seats of ASU & H courses should be at par with State Quota seats. (Ref. Ministry's letter no. AA- 11013/2/2023-EP-I dated 24.08.2023)
18. ASU & H Govt./ Govt. aided/ CU/NI institutes should ensure that to contribute only Stipendiary seats towards All India Quota-PG seats for AACCC-PG counseling.
19. ASU & H colleges/ institutes must fill in **factual information** (objective information/data like accommodation, mess facility, hostel fees, etc.) in the Institute Profile. (Ref. Ministry's letter AA- 13013/1/2023 dated 06.06.2023).

Sir/Madam

With reference to the subject mentioned above I am hereby directed to inform you that all participating candidates of UG Counselling 2025 who want to apply under PwBD category that in compliance with the directives issued by the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in the matter of Om Rathod Vs. Union of India & Others and connected matters, the National Commission for Indian System of Medicine (NCISM) and National Commission for Homoeopathy, in its joint commission meeting discussed to review Appendix A and B of National Commission for Indian System of Medicine (Minimum Standards of Undergraduate Ayurveda Education) Regulations-2022 with the objective to align the guidelines with the provisions of the Rights of Persons with Disabilities Act 2016, and the subsequent notification issued by the Ministry of Social Justice and Empowerment (MoSJE) on 12.03.2024.

In this respect as per decision, in the meeting of Joint Commission, both the Commissions unanimously agreed to adopt interim Guidelines for the PwBD category issued by NMC for admissions for ASU courses in AY 2025-26 to ensure parity and standardization across medical education systems.

Accordingly, the NCISM has resolved that all candidates with benchmark disabilities, who possess a valid UDID card issued by the Department of Empowerment of Persons with Disabilities (DEPWD) and further meet the NEET UG eligibility criteria, shall be considered for admission in BAMS/BUMS/BSMS course, under the PwBD category.

Further, it is informed that, the following documents must be mandatorily submitted by PwBD candidates at the time of reporting to designated disability centers of MCC for obtaining disability certificates for the academic year 2025-26:

- NEET UG 2025 result demonstrating eligibility for the BAMS/BUMS/BSMS course.
- Valid UDID card (Yellow or above) issued by the DEPWD (excluding visual disabilities)
- Self-certified affidavits in the prescribed format, specific to the candidate's disability category, as provided in Schedule-I (Copy enclosed)
- The candidate will have to approach the designated Medical Board for verification of their self-certified affidavits.


In light of above facts, PwBD candidates participating in UG Counselling 2025 for ASU courses, are advised to note the following points w.r.t obtaining Disability Certificate for the purpose of upcoming NEET UG Counselling, from designated disability centers of MCC:

  - Valid UDID card (Yellow or above) issued by the DEPwD (excluding visual disabilities)
  - Self-certification form in the prescribed format of NCISM as provided in Appendix-A (Copy enclosed)
  - Affidavits, specific to the candidate's disability category, in the prescribed format of NCISM as provided in Appendix-B to F (Copy enclosed)
- The certificate will be generated by the center as per details of disability mentioned on the UDID card, affidavit submitted by the PwBD candidate, fulfillment of eligibility criteria subject to Board assessment of functional competencies
- For disabilities other than the one already discussed in respect of Locomotor, Hearing, Visual and SLD/ASD/ Mental Illness, they will have to submit a valid UDID card and the self-certified affidavit prescribed in Appendix-A under the category "Others".

## INTERIM GUIDELINES ON ASSESSMENT METHOD FOR GRANTING ADMISSION IN BAMS/BUMS/BSMS COURSE TO PwBD CANDIDATES FOR AY 2025-26

### Preamble:

The National Commission for Indian System of Medicine (NCISM) is committed to promoting equitable and inclusive access to undergraduate education in Ayurveda, Siddha, and Unani (ASU) systems for all eligible candidates, including Persons with Benchmark Disabilities (PwBD).

In accordance with the *Rights of Persons with Disabilities Act, 2016* and the *NCISM (Minimum Standards of Undergraduate Education) Regulations, 2022*, this interim report outlines key measures to support the admission of PwBD candidates to BAMS, BUMS, and BSMS courses.

The report highlights essential areas such as disability assessment, eligibility criteria, reasonable accommodations, accessibility standards, and institutional readiness. It aims to strengthen existing systems and ensure a fair, dignified, and inclusive educational environment.

NCISM envisions a diverse ASU medical workforce where every student, regardless of ability, can pursue a career in medicine and serve society with competence and compassion.

### 1. Introduction

In alignment with the *Rights of Persons with Disabilities (RPwD) Act, 2016*, and subsequent directives—most notably the notification issued by the Ministry of Social Justice and Empowerment (MoSJE) dated 12.03.2024 emphasizing inclusive education and reasonable accommodation—and the Hon'ble Supreme Court's judgment dated 25.10.2024 in *Om Rathod vs. Union of India & Others* (SLP (C) No. 21942 of 2024), a significant shift has been initiated in the national approach to disability inclusion in higher education.

These developments reinforce the mandate for inclusive policies and practices, guiding institutions to adopt measures that ensure equal access and meaningful participation of Persons with Benchmark Disabilities (PwBD) in medical education.

### 2. Functional Competency Approach

Recent legal and policy developments highlight the shift from rigid percentage-based disability thresholds to a more inclusive, functional competency-based assessment. In response, the National Commission for Indian System of Medicine (NCISM) has adopted proactive measures to address challenges faced by Persons with Benchmark Disabilities (PwBD).

These measures include the provision of reasonable accommodations, revision of eligibility criteria, and adoption of assessment methods that prioritize individual functional capabilities over numerical disability percentages, thereby fostering a fair and inclusive learning environment.

### 3. Deliberations and Guideline Development

Extensive deliberations were undertaken during a joint commission meeting of the National Commission for Indian System of Medicine (NCISM) and the National Commission for



Homoeopathy (NCH). A consensus was reached to develop comprehensive guidelines centered on functional ability and the provision of reasonable accommodations, ensuring the fair inclusion of PwBD candidates in the BAMS, BUMS, and BSMS programs—without causing undue hardship or exclusion.

This initiative aims to strengthen existing systems, address practical challenges, and formulate evidence-based recommendations to foster an enabling academic environment rooted in dignity, non-discrimination, and equal opportunity. Key focus areas include disability assessment, eligibility norms, reasonable accommodations, accessibility standards, and institutional readiness.

#### **4. Interim Admission Approach for AY 2025–26**

The identification and definition of essential competencies for each type of disability is a highly complex, multi-dimensional, and evolving process. It requires careful consideration of a range of factors, including the nature and extent of functional limitations, the role of assistive devices and emerging medical technologies, and the demands of clinical training and patient safety. Striking an appropriate balance between the principles of inclusion and the imperatives of clinical competence and patient care is of utmost importance in the context of medical education.

Undergraduate ASU programs—spanning Ayurveda, Siddha, and Unani disciplines—entail diverse skill sets and clinical requirements that vary significantly across specializations. As such, the development of final disability inclusion guidelines necessitates specialty-specific consultations with medical educators, experts, practitioners, beneficiaries, and other relevant stakeholders. These deliberations will help ensure that the final framework is both inclusive and aligned with professional standards of practice.

In view of the above, the final guidelines—once all procedural requirements, stakeholder consultations, and expert reviews are completed—will be formally notified and implemented from subsequent academic years.

Meanwhile, to avoid disruption and ensure continuity in the admission process for Persons with Benchmark Disabilities (PwBD), an interim admission framework shall be followed for the Academic Year 2025–26. This interim approach will uphold the spirit of inclusion while maintaining essential academic and clinical standards until the comprehensive guidelines are finalized.

#### **5. Functional Assessment of Disabilities**

- The earlier numerical disability thresholds are no longer applicable.
- Assessment will prioritize the candidate's functional ability to meet academic and clinical demands of BAMS, BUMS, and BSMS courses.

#### **6. Mandatory Use of UDID Portal**

- As per Gazette Notification S.O. 1736(E) dated 05.05.2021 by the Department of Empowerment of Persons with Disabilities (DEPwD), all disability certificates and UDID cards must be issued through the UDID online portal from June 1, 2021 onwards.
- The UDID card is the mandatory and authoritative proof for verifying disability status for NEET UG candidates applying under the disability category.



#### 7. Evaluation Framework Based on MoSJE Guidelines

- Candidate assessment will follow the Ministry of Social Justice and Empowerment (MoSJE) guidelines notified on 12.03.2024.
- These guidelines ensure a uniform, comprehensive evaluation that balances patient safety, clinical competence, and inclusive access

#### 8. Institutional Responsibilities under the RPwD Act

The ASU medical colleges as per the recommendations prescribed under RPwD Act, 2016, shall make maximum efforts in accommodating and facilitating the candidates with disabilities:

- **Non-Discrimination in Admission and Education (Section 16):**  
*Institutions must ensure that no student with a disability is denied admission on the grounds of disability and must provide an inclusive education system at all levels.*
- **Infrastructure Accessibility (Section 45):**  
*Institutions must ensure barrier-free access to buildings, classrooms, libraries, laboratories, hostels, and other facilities as per the standards notified by the Government of India.*
- **Sensitization and Capacity Building:**  
*Colleges are encouraged to conduct awareness and sensitization programs for faculty, staff, and students to promote an inclusive environment and reduce attitudinal barriers.*
- **Nodal Officer for Disability Affairs:**  
*Institutions are advised to appoint a dedicated Nodal Officer or establish a Disability Cell to address the concerns and support needs of students with disabilities.*
- **Grievance Redressal Mechanism:**  
*An accessible and responsive grievance redressal system must be in place to address complaints related to discrimination or lack of accommodation.*

#### 9. Decision Taken

In the meeting of Joint Commission, both the Commissions unanimously agreed to adopt interim Guidelines for the PwBD category, issued by NMC for admissions for ASU courses in AY 2025-26 to ensure parity and standardization across medical education systems.

- PwBD candidates must submit:
  - A valid UDID card issued by a designated medical authority under MoSJE.
  - Self-Certified affidavits in the format provided under Schedule -1.
  - The candidate will have to approach the designated medical board for verification of their self-certified affidavit.
- Designated Medical Boards (16 designated medical boards) are required to undertake following duties:
  - The competencies mentioned in the appendix under Schedule-I are basic & mandatory. The candidates, to the satisfaction of the designated medical board, may demonstrate the competencies that have been declared by him/her. If the board finds the declared competencies unsubstantiated based on

- the candidate's performance, it must issue a reasoned decision declaring him/her ineligible to pursue ASU medical course.
- If the candidate while self-declaring the essential competencies mentions one or more competencies in negative or is not able to demonstrate one or more of the listed essential competencies, the board shall see if he/she is able to compensate such deficits, by other alternative functionalities; and may take a holistic view regarding his capability to pursue BAMS/BUMS/BSMS course.
  - The designated medical boards may utilize standardized tests and tools to evaluate the abilities of the candidates, as per their declaration, instead of focusing on the disabilities.
  - All decisions of the designated medical board(s) shall be in the form speaking orders.

Admissions will be processed by the counseling authority, based on NEET 2025 scores, institutional preferences, and verification of required documents by the concerned designated medical board(s). ASU Medical colleges will provide accommodations accordingly.

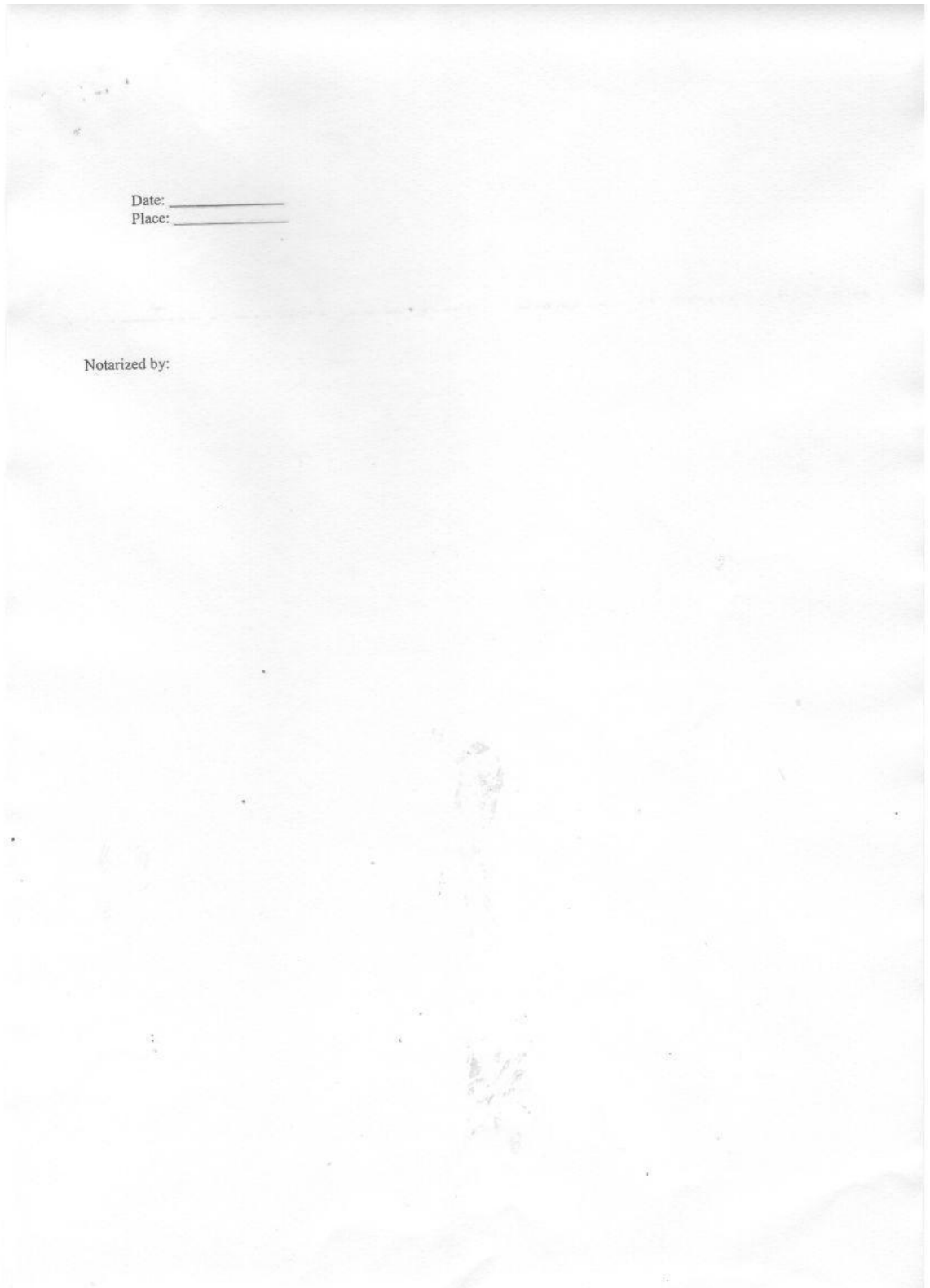

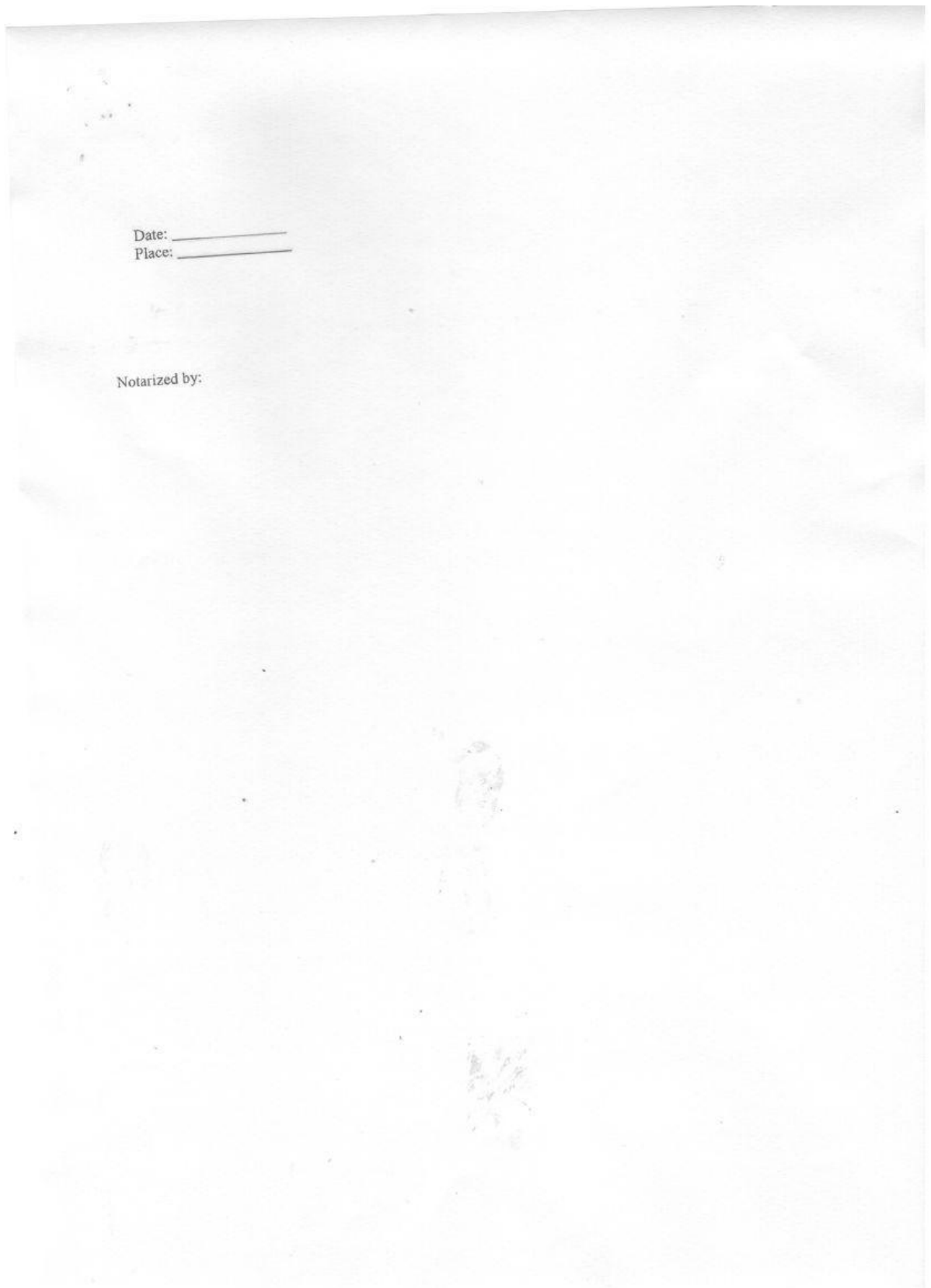

I am directed to invite your attention to the Punjab Government Circular Letter No.1/3/95-3PP II/2043, dated 29/1/1996 vide which the instructions were issued regarding simplification of procedure for obtaining the certificate of Domicile for purposes of admission to educational institutions (including technical/medical institution). The matter has been reconsidered in the light of judgement delivered by the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in the case of Dr. Pradeep Jain Vs. Union of India and others reported as AIR 1984-SC-4121 wherein it was held that instead of the word 'Domicile' the word 'Residence' be used in the instructions issued by the State Government on the subject. Accordingly, it has been decided by the Government to revise the Government instructions referred to above as under:

With reference to letter No.1/3/95-3P/9619, dated the 6th June, 1996 of this Department on the subject noted above and to say that keeping in view the hardship being faced by the Employees in getting the 'Residence Certificate' it has been decided to decentralize the powers of issuing the 'Residence Certificate' in process of the categories mentioned below:-

- a) The employees of Punjab Government posted in or outside Punjab State or working on deputation having at least 3 years of service.
- b) the employees of Government of India posted in Chandigarh or in Punjab in connection with the affairs of the Punjab Government for a period of 3 years.
- c) the employees of State Government institutions/undertaking who are posted in Chandigarh or in Punjab in connection with the affairs of the Punjab Government for a period of 3 years.
- d) the employees having at least 3 years of service in autonomous bodies/companies in which Punjab Government has 20% or more shares.

The Heads of the office shall be competent to issue the requisite certificate to the employees with the exception that in the case of head of Office, the Head of the Department shall be the Competent Authority to issue the certificate

From: Chief Secretary to Government of Punjab to all the Heads of the department etc.  
Subject: Issuance of certificate for the purpose of seeking admission to various educational/technical/professional institutions in the state and also for employment.

Sir,

It has been brought to the notice of Government that educational authorities and institutions prescribe various certificates regarding residence, SC/BC category and backward area etc. to be furnished by the students/candidates with the applications forms for entrance examinations or employment in the formats and by the authorities different from those prescribed by the Government departments. Cases have also been reported where the authorities concerned insist on retaining original certificates and refuse to accept the attested photo copies of the certificates. All this results in harassment and panic among the students/candidates and their parents/guardian, since they have to apply with such certificates to more than one authorities simultaneously and within a limited period. The lists of certificates required at the time of applying for CET/PMET/PMT and PAU are enclosed by way of illustration.

2. In order to overcome the difficulty mentioned above, it has been decided by the Government that following procedure has been decided by the Government that the following procedure shall be followed meticulously by all the educational and other authorities concerned:-

- i) Certificates issued in the format and by the authorities prescribed by the Government Departments shall be accepted as valid by all educational institutions and other authorities.
- ii) Where a number of authorities have been authorized to issue the certificates there shall be no insistence on issue of a certificate by any particular authority or by the highest authority indicated in the format.
- iii)(a) In case of entrance examinations, no certificate should be called for in the first instance alongwith the application form. It will be sufficient for the candidate seeking admission or other facility to indicate in the application from whether he/she belongs to any particular category entitling him/her to certain concessions or facility. Requisite certificates may be obtained only from the selected/wait listed candidates.
- iii)(b) To further simplify the procedure attested copies of the certificates only shall be retained and original certificates if required to be produced at the time of interview shall be returned immediately, thereafter.
- iv) Parents/guardian or candidates can also obtain SC certificates from the Head of the institution where the candidates has studied if the proof is available in the school records.
- v) The persons who are employed in Government of India or any other State Government are to be treated at par with the employees of the Government of Punjab in the matter of issue of Scheduled Caste certificate provided relevant Scheduled Caste certificate exists in their service record. The Scheduled Caste certificate in such will be issued by the respective Heads of Departments in the Proforma below:-

Please refer to the subject cited above.

2. In pursuance of insertion of Article 15(6) and Article 16(6) in the Constitution of India vide the Constitution (One hundred and third Amendment) Act, 2019, the Ministry of Social Justice & Empowerment, Govt. of India has issued policy vide O.M. No.F.No.20013/01/2018-BC-II dated 17.01.2019 to provide 10% reservation in civil posts and services in Govt. of India and admission in Educational Institutions to Economically Weaker sections (EWSs) who are not covered under the existing scheme of reservation for the Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes and the Socially and economically Backward Classes.

3. On the basis of O.M dated 17.01.2019, DoPT vide OM F. NO. 36039/01/2019-ESit.(Res)-II dated 19.01.2019 has notified that 10% reservation would be provided for Economically Weaker Sections (EWSs) in central government posts and services. DoPT vide OM F. NO. 36039/01/2019-ESit.(Res)-II dated 31.01.2019 has inter-alia issued detailed instructions regarding procedure for implementation of EWS reservation. The copies of the OM dated 19.01.2019 and OM 31.01.2019 is available on the link <https://dopt.gov.in/notifications/oms-and-orders> which may be referred to.

4. Similarly, Ministry of HRD vide OM F.No. 12-4/2019-U1 dated 17.01.2019 has issued instructions to provide reservation in admission to Central educational institutions. This OM is available on the link [https://www.ugc.ac.in/ugc\\_notices.aspx](https://www.ugc.ac.in/ugc_notices.aspx).

5. In view of these instructions, the following persons are eligible for being issued the Income & Assets Certificate for availing the benefit of reservation for Economically Weaker Sections for admission to Central Educational Institutions and for Central Govt. posts and Services:-

a) Persons who are not covered under the scheme of reservation by Govt. of India for SCs, STs and OBCs and

b) Whose gross family income is below Rs. 8.00 lakh (Rs. Eight lacs only) per annum. Income shall include income from all sources i.e. salary, agriculture, business profession etc. for the financial year prior to the year of application.

c) All persons whose family owns or possesses any of the following assets shall be excluded from being identified as EWSs, irrespective of the family income:-

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- i. 5 acres of Agricultural Land and above;
- ii. Residential flat of 1000 sq. ft. and above;
- iii. Residential plot of 100 sq. yards and above in notified municipalities;
- iv. Residential plot of 200 sq. yards and above in areas other than notified municipalities.


d) The property held by a "Family" in different locations or different places/cities would be clubbed while applying the land or property holding test to determine EWS status.

e) The term "Family" for this purpose will include the person who seeks benefit of reservation, his/her parents and siblings below the age of 18 years as also his/her spouse and children below the age of 18 years.


6. It has been decided that the applicant will present an application and self declaration as per Annexure-A and B respectively. The certificate will be issued as per specimen given in Annexure -C and will be valid for the financial year in which it is issued.

7. The concerned Tehsildar will be the Income and Assets Certificate issuing authority. He will issue the certificate after carefully verifying the claim and all relevant documents.

8. In special circumstances, the Deputy Commissioner may, by an order in writing, authorise the Sub-Divisional Magistrate of the area to issue the certificate.


