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1. INTRODUCTION

BRIEF HISTORY:

Guru Ravidas Ayurved University Punjab, Hoshiarpur was created with the promulgation of the Guru Ravidas Ayurved University Punjab Act, 2009 (Punjab Act No. 4 of 2010) by the Punjab Legislative Assembly. The University started functioning w.e.f. 01.02.2011. The main campus of the University is located in the foothills of Himalayas on Hoshiarpur-Una Road in 33 Acre of Land in village Kharkan (10 KM from Hoshiarpur city). The University has its own well constructed Administrative Block in approximately 5 Acre of land. This University regulates the conduct of undergraduate post-graduate Ayurvedic, Homeopathic , Unani and Ph.D teachings.

UNIVERSITY'S PRESENT STATUS:

This University is one of its own kinds in North India. At present the University has total 20 affiliated colleges viz 16 Ayurvedic, 3 Homoeopathy and 1 Unani college. The P.G training in 3 M.D Ayurvedic and 1 Homoeopathic colleges in various departments are being imparted under the affiliation of this University . The University has started Ph.D in four departments of Ayurveda from the year 2020. It has about 6,000 registered students presently undergoing undergraduate. Postgraduate and Ph.D studies.

In addition to the academic activities, the University has also been providing health care services through its AYUSH OPD to the people of nearby villages.

The University has been striving to bring about major development in AYUSH and all basic, clinical and allied departments to pursue on education and research. Meritorious AYUSH faculties from all over the country are getting aspired to work in this University.

Admissions to various post graduate courses in the affiliated institutions of this University in the State of Punjab are made on merit basis of AIA-PGET-2024.

4. ELIGIBILITY

MD(Ayurveda)

A person possessing the Bachelor Degree in Ayurved of a University or Board or Medical Institution specified in the second schedule to the Act notified by the Department of AYUSH, Govt. of India/CCIM/NCISM, shall be eligible for admission to the Postgraduate degree course.

Note: Please check Notification of Govt. of India, Ministry of AYUSH for instructions regarding last date of Compulsory Rotatory Internship.

5) FEE REQUIRED WITH ONLINE APPLICATION FORM:

- a) Rs. 2000/- to be deposited online by using Debit card or Credit card through University website i.e. www.graupunjab.org by due date and time for State Quota and All India Quota Candidates.
- c) **Fee once deposited in University account will not be refunded/adjusted.**

6. IMPORTANT INSTRUCTIONS TO FILL ONLINE ADMISSION APPLICATION FORM.

- i) Before applying, candidate should carefully read PROSPECTUS for eligibility conditions and other important conditions.
- ii) Only one application is to be submitted by a candidate. Submitting more than one Application by a candidate is liable to be rejected.

- iii) After filling online Application Form by candidate, University will issue a unique Registration Id. Registration Id (i.e. login Id will be provided to the candidate at his/her registered Mobile Number through SMS and email.
- v) Candidate should apply online on or before 23.09.2024 After this online application form will not be available at the University website and no request will be entertained in this regard.

7. MERIT LIST

8. CHOICE OF THE SUBJECTS

The candidate can apply for more than one specialty and he/she would be considered as per his/her merit on the basis of AIAPGET-2024.

- (a) When two or more candidates have secured equal marks in the AIAPGET-2024 then inter-se-merit shall be determined as under:-
- i. Candidate with higher marks in qualifying examination.
 - ii. Candidate older in age

9. ONLINE COUNSELLING

1. Online counselling will be conducted through University Website and online counselling form will be made available on University website as per dates specified in Important Dates column.
2. In case of physical counselling, personal appearance of candidates is essential at the time of interview/counseling and exemptions from personal appearance may not be sought as it shall not be granted.
3. The candidates should read the eligibility conditions carefully and just exercising online option of college/ appearing in counselling does not entitle him/her for admission.
4. Eligibility conditions for admissions are as per Punjab Govt. Notification(s). The eligibility shall be determined by the Admission Committee at the time of counseling. Those who are not eligible as per Punjab Govt. notification will not be considered for admission. The candidates will appear in counselling at their own risk & responsibility.
5. The allotment of seat and college shall be made as per the choice of the candidate at the time of the counselling by the Admission Committee on the basis of the merit determined as per marks obtained by the candidate in AIAPGET -2024 and other terms and conditions contained in the Punjab Government Notification for admission to MD (Ayurveda) Courses.
6. The candidates shall have to produce all the certificates/degrees/diplomas/ documents in original at the time of joining/admission in respective colleges or at the time of physical counseling.
7. The choice(s) of courses/ institutions shall be exercised by the candidate online.
8. **Checking/Verification of Original Certificate/Documents** :Allocation of seat is provisional subject to verification of original documents/checking of eligibility by the Principal of concerned Ayurvedic Colleges. After provisional allocation of seat, candidate shall have to report to the

allocated college for getting challan form, verification of documents and checking of eligibility. It is the sole responsibility of the Principal to authenticate the eligibility of the provisionally allocated candidate before their joining/admission.

9. **Deposition of Annual Fee after provisional allocation** : Candidate will deposit tuition fee (as per Punjab Govt. notification) in the form of Demand Draft in the favour of Registrar Guru Ravidas Ayurved University, Payable at Hoshiarpur . Candidate will report for medical checkup and joining after submission of proof of fee deposition to the respective college within stipulated time period, failing which allocated seat will stand cancelled automatically without any intimation to the candidate.

In case of physical counselling candidate will have to deposit tuition fee as specified in the Punjab Govt. notification on the spot at the venue of counselling in the shape of Demand Draft in favour of "Registrar, Guru Ravidas Ayurved University " payable at "Hoshiarpur" failing which his/her provisional selection will be treated as cancelled without any intimation to the candidate.

Subject: Admission to Post Graduate Ayurveda/Homeopathy courses in the State of Punjab for the Academic Session 2021-22 onwards.

1. The Governor of Punjab is pleased to notify the policy for admissions to AYUSH Post Graduate Courses in suppression of all the earlier notifications issued in this regard. This shall be applicable for admission to Post Graduate Courses in Ayurveda and Homeopathy in all participating and affiliated colleges in the State of Punjab for the Academic Session 2021-22 onwards.
2. The Governor of Punjab is further pleased to notify that all the institutions whether Government or Private, aided or unaided, minority or non-minority, shall be covered by this notification
3. All admissions to AYUSH PG courses –M.D. Ayurveda and M.D Homeopathy, in the Government and Private Institutions situated in the state of Punjab shall be based on the merit of all India AYUSH Post Graduate Entrance Test (AIA-PGET) which is conducted from time to time.
4. **Eligibility Criteria:** A candidate seeking admission to MD/MS Ayurveda/ Homeopathy Courses and will be eligible if he/she:
 - i. Has passed BAMS/BHMS examination from Recognized Universities from UGC and from the Institution recognized by the NCISM/Ministry of Ayush, New Delhi.
 - ii. Candidate should have completed satisfactorily one year compulsory Rotatory Internship from Institutions recognized by the NCISM/NCH/State Govt./Ministry of AYUSH for this purpose by 31.12.2021, as per Public Notice issued by NTA dating 17th August 2021 and consequent years as per AIAPGET eligibility criteria/ NCISM/NCH norms.
 - iii. The candidate should be registered with the Board of Ayurvedic and Unani System of Medicine, Punjab/ NCISM/NCH, New Delhi.

iv. All candidates (General/SC/ST/OBC/Handicapped/EWS) desirous of seeking admissions in any category of seats should fulfill the minimum eligibility criteria/qualifications/qualifying criteria as prescribed in the information bulletin for AIAPGET-2021 issued by NTA for the Academic year 2021-22 and as per regulations of NCISM/NCH issued from time to time.

v. No candidate who has failed to obtain the minimum eligibility marks (as specified in AIAPGET-2021) shall be eligible for admission to MD/MS (Ayurveda) Courses.

5. It is further notified that in the participating and affiliated colleges covered under this notification, 15% of the seats shall be under All India Merit Category of AIA-PGET, counseling for which is conducted by Department of AYUSH Government of India / National Commission for Indian Systems of Medicine. Remaining 85% seats shall be reserved for State Quota seats, where preference will be given to candidates who are residents of Punjab, even if they are lower in merit to the candidates from outside the State. The State quota seats may be filled by candidates from other states, only when no candidates from within the State is available after conducting of final counseling.

6. In the Government Ayurvedic College, Patiala, 25% of the State quota seats will be reserved for Ayurvedic Medical Officers (AMO) and remaining 75% will be for other categories, which will be allotted each year as per the roster maintained by the college based on the total seats approved by NCISM. Any vacant seats due to non-availability of eligible candidates under 25% in service category shall be offered to the eligible candidates under 75% quota and vice-versa.

6.1) For seats in each speciality (in service A.M.O's) under 25% quota:

- (a) These seats shall be open to the candidates who have completed five years of service. Date of eligibility shall be the last date of submission of application form. A Certificate regarding length of service as A.M.O. and NOC is required from the competent authority i.e. Director, Research & Medical Education, Punjab, SAS Nagar, Mohali /Director, Ayurveda Punjab, Chandigarh.
- (b) Ayurvedic Medical Officers selected under 25% quota will be sanctioned two years study leave and one year leave of kind due in terms of the policy of the Department of Health and Family welfare's order issued vide; Endorsement No. 2/4/2010-2Health-7/2126-81, dated 17/07/2014.
- (c) As per Punjab Govt. Notification Endst No. 2/109/2011-5SS3/8363-8367 dated 28.09.2021, the following will also apply:-
AMOs admitted under 25% quota at Government Ayurvedic College, Patiala will have to execute a Bond to serve the Punjab Government for five years after completing MD (Ayurveda). This Bond will be of Rs.15.00 Lakhs (Rupees

Fifteen Lakhs). In case, the person does not serve the Punjab Government for five year, after the completion of MD (Ayurveda) he/she will have to pay Rs.15.00 Lakhs to the Punjab Government.

6.2) For 75% seats in each specialty (open to all eligible Punjab residents):-

(a) A candidate holding recognized basic qualification in Ayurvedic System of Medicine i.e. B.A.M.S/G.A.M.S who are residents of the State of Punjab must produce domicile certificate as per Department of Personnel (Personnel Policies Branch) vide letters No. 1/3/95-3PP11/9619, dated 6 June 1996 and No. 1/2/95/-3PP11/81 dated 1st January 1999, shall be eligible irrespective of the college from where they have graduated.

(b) As per Punjab Govt. Notification Endst No. 2/109/2011-5SS3/8363-8367, dated 28.09.2021, the following will also apply:-

The persons admitted under 75% quota at Government Ayurvedic College, Patiala will have to execute a Bond to serve the Punjab Government for one year after completing MD (Ayurveda). In case, the person does not serve the Punjab Government for one year, he/she will have to pay Rs. 2.00 Lakhs (Rupees Two Lakhs) to the Punjab Government and he/she will also have to pay back the stipend to the Government.

(c) Any candidate holding any employment either in public or private sector shall have to produce a "No Objection Certificate" from his/her employer.

7. **Determination of merit for admission :-**

(a) Marks secured by the candidate in the All India AYUSH Post Graduate Entrance test (AIA-PGET)

(b) There will be separate merit list for in service quota candidates i.e. 25% (AMO's) and a separate merit list for those who are not covered under the category of in service. The merit list for open and reserved category will be separate. The category filled in application form will be final. If any candidate has not filled the category then he/she will be considered in open category.

(c) Where two or more candidates have equal marks in the AIA-PGET the merit of such candidates shall be determined in order of preference as under:-

i) Candidates obtaining higher aggregate marks in B.A.M.S / G.A.M.S qualifying examination.

ii) If marks in degree are same then the candidate older in age.

8. **Reservation (Government / Private) institutions:** The reservation for various categories in post Graduate admission will be as under:-

(a) Scheduled caste	25%
(b) Backward classes	10%
(c) Physically disabled	05%
(d) Economically Weaker Section (EWS)	10%

(In Govt. College Only)

For Scheduled Caste and Backward classes {(a & b) above}:

(i) Candidates claiming benefits of reservation under S.C/B.C category will be required to produce a certificate from the competent authority as per instruction No.1/41/96/RC/1/11001-17 dated Chandigarh 5.12.1996 (for SC) and 1/41/93-RC/459 dated 17/1/1994 (For BC) issued by the Department of Welfare.

(ii) Candidate belonging to S.C/B.C will be eligible for admission as per their combined merit in AIA-PGET.

For Physically disabled {(c) above}; The admission under this category shall be governed by the guidelines regarding specified Disabilities issued by the Government under the Rights of Person with Disabilities Act, 2016.

For EWS category {(d) above}; The candidates claiming admission under this category will be required to submit Income and Asset/ Income Disclosure Certificate valid for 2021-22 issued by the Competent Authority as per the instructions issued by the Govt. from time to time.

Explanation:- The following points shall be observed while granting above mentioned reservation:

- The reservation will be made college wise in each specialty separately subject to the availability of seats as per instructions of the Govt. of Punjab issued from time to time.
- A hundred point roster for all categories of seats quota wise/subject wise shall be maintained by Participating/Affiliated College(s) which will be verified by Guru Ravidas Ayurveda University, Hoshiarpur for allotment of seats as notified by NCISM/Govt. of Punjab.

Note: The candidate shall have to bring, in original, all the relevant certificates/ documents at the time of document verification without which admission to MD/MS (Ayurveda) Courses shall not be granted. Attested photocopies of certificates/documents will not

be considered valid for the purpose of counseling and the seat allocated to them shall be cancelled.

- i. A student who is already admitted to any PG Courses including PG Diploma course in any Institution is not eligible to apply till the completion of the course.
- ii. After commencement of PG courses if a candidate having joined the Institute but leaves the course after the three days prior to the last date of admission as prescribed by NCISM New Delhi, then he/she will be debarred for next five years from applying for admission to any PG Course in the State.
- iii. Candidate will have to submit a declaration to the effect that they have not abandoned the post graduate seat after opting for admission or after getting admitted in post graduate courses in the state of Punjab in the previous year.
- iv. Candidates who join the course will not be allowed to do private practice, in case of violation the candidature shall be cancelled and he/she will be debarred for 5 years.
- v. Concealment of facts or false declaration by the candidate shall lead to cancellation of admission of the candidate.
- vi. Personal appearance for counselling/interview is compulsory for all candidates applying for the post graduates admission. No separate interview letters will be issued.

12. **Choice of subject**

- (a) The allotment of specialty shall be made on the basis of the merit obtained by the candidate in the AIA-PGET. This choice of the subject will be obtained by the candidate at the time of interview, which will be final and, if the candidate does not join, or leaves the course in between, he/she will be debarred for a period of five years for admission to P.G Course in the state of Punjab.
- (b) Once admission is granted on the basis of choice of candidate, no change of specialty, category shall be allowed.
- (c) For each specialty a waiting list will be prepared and if any vacancy subsequently arises, the same will be filled from within the waiting list.
- (d) The last date for admission, filling up the vacancies and date for joining the college and the course shall be fixed by Guru Ravidas Ayurved University, Hoshiarpur in terms of the notification issued by NCISM from time to time.

13. Fee and Stipend:- Fee structure will be as per notification no. 05/14/2021-1HB3/9202, dated 10.11.2021 is as under:-

13.1 M.D. Ayurveda Courses

- (i) Govt. Ayurvedic College, Patiala
1st year 80,000/- per year with 5% annual increase.
2nd year 90,000/- per year with 5% annual increase.
3rd year 1,00,000/- per year with 5% annual increase.
- (ii) Private Ayurvedic Colleges-
2,50,000/- per year with 5% annual increase.

13.2 Hostel fee and security:- As notified by Punjab Govt. from time to time.

13.3 Stipend:

- (i) Stipend to the students admitted in Government Ayurvedic College, Patiala will be as per the decision of the Government from time to time.
- (ii) Stipend to the candidates admitted in private colleges will be as decided by the Government separately.

13.4 Fee in Homoeopathic college will be as under:-

The institute will charge fee of Rs 1,25,000/- per annum. The fee will be payable on annual basis.

14. The schedule for commencement of classes, cut-off date for admission, joining date to college etc. shall be in accordance with the schedule notified by the National Commission for Indian System of Medicine (NCISM) and National Council of Homoeopathy (NCH) from time to time.

15. In case if there is any vacancy occurs after the first round of counseling due to any reason, such seats will be filled up during the second round of counselling.

- a) Fresh registration shall be allowed for participating in the second round. Fresh candidates will have to register themselves for the admission. The candidates are advised to regularly visit the website of Guru Ravidas Ayurveda University, Hoshiarpur for updates.
- b) The candidates, who have already registered themselves for first round and wish to participate in the second round, shall not be required to register again. However, they shall have to give their willingness/option to participate in the second round of counselling by submitting the previous form again with the same registration number, the security fee and change of choices if any.

- c) The candidate who wishes to participate in the 2nd round of PG Counseling shall be required to submit Security Fee as per GRAU, Hoshiarpur.
- d) The fresh candidates will also have to submit registration fee as per GRAU, Hoshiarpur. If a candidate does not deposit the requisite amount then he/she shall not be eligible to participate in the 2nd round of Counselling.
- e) The candidate who have been allotted seat in the first round shall have a right to retain already allotted seat and this shall be changed only if he/she gets an updated and opted seat during second round. However, the candidates who wish to participate in the 2nd round of online counselling will have to submit their preferences afresh again. Candidates, who have been allotted, seat in first round should give the fresh choices in order of preferences for the College/Course/Specialty in which they wish to upgrade themselves.
- f) The candidates who are allotted seats in the 2nd round of counseling but do not join or leave after joining, their security fee submitted shall stand forfeited, however they will be eligible to participate in the 3rd /mop-up round.

- l) If the seats remain vacant even after 3rd/Mop-up Round of Counseling then left-over seats will be filled up by clearing the waiting list by GRAU, Hoshiarpur.
- m) Shifting to other college/subject/specialty will be allowed only in 2nd round of counseling and not thereafter.







FOR THE ACADEMIC SESSION 2024-2025**

A. DIRECTIVE FOR COUNSELING AUTHORITIES (Central/State/UT)

I. Directive for Central/State/UT Counseling and Admissions

Eligibility Criteria to Participate in the Counseling. -

1. Colleges/Institute who have received permission from the Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine (MARBISM) of National Commission for Indian System of Medicine (NCISM)/ Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Homoeopathy (MARBH) of National Commission for Homoeopathy (NCH) / Government of India, New Delhi, for admission to ASU&H-PG courses for the academic session 2024-2025 shall only be eligible to participate in the counseling process.

Seat Matrix (AIQ & State/UT Quota).-

2. The seat matrix for admission in the Government, Government-aided institutions, and Private Institutions shall be fifteen per cent (15%) for All-India Quota and eighty-five per cent (85%) for State/Union Territory Quota as specified in the NCISM Act 2020/ Indian Medicine Central Council (Post Graduate Education) Amendment Regulations, 2018 for Ayurveda, Siddha & Unani for admissions in ASU-PG courses and NCH Act 2020/ NCH (Homoeopathy Post-Graduate Degree Course- Doctor of Medicine in Homoeopathy) Regulations, 2024 for admissions in Homoeopathy-PG courses, or regulations in force at the time of admission.

Provided that-

- i. the AIQ for the purpose of admission in all the Deemed Universities (both Government and Private - established under Central Act), shall be hundred per cent;
- ii. the University and institute, which are already having more than fifteen per cent All-India Quota seats, shall continue to maintain that quota;
- iii. five per cent. of the annual sanctioned intake capacity in Government and Government-aided institutions shall be filled up by candidate with specified disability in accordance with the provisions of the Rights of Persons with Disabilities Act, 2016 (49 of 2016) and based on the merit list of AIAPGET-2024.

3. In case of 85% of State/UT quota, the seat matrix for Government Quota, Management Quota, NRI quota etc., shall be as per respective State and UT policy; however, all admissions in all quotas (except foreign nationals) shall be through counseling conducted by State/UT counseling authority.

4. The Management seats under the State/UT Quota in Private Institutions shall be treated as domicile-free.

Reservation. -

5. Category-wise reservation of seats shall be as per Central or State or UT Reservation Policy, as the case may be.

6. Reservation for allotment of 15% AIQ-PG seats in Private ASU&H Institutes:- all AIQ- PG seats of Private ASU & H Institutes are open in nature (all category candidates are eligible). However, as mentioned in relevant regulations, the relaxation in qualifying criteria may be provided category-wise.

Counseling schedule:

7. Central and State/UT counseling authorities shall prepare the counseling schedule for the A.Y. 2024-2025 in concurrence with the schedule specified by NCISM/NCH as given below:

Counseling and Admissions.-

8. All sanctioned/permitted seats by the Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine(MARBISM)/NCISM/ Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Homoeopathy (MARBH)/NCH/Government of India, irrespective of categories/reservations, are to be filled only through online counseling, i.e., Central/State/UT counseling as the case may be(except foreign nationals).
9. Ayush Admissions Central Counseling Committee (AACCC), Ministry of Ayush will conduct "AIQ-PG Online Counseling" for admission to AIQ (15%) seats under Govt./Govt. Aided Colleges/ Central Universities /National Institutes and Deemed Universities (Established under Central Act) of ASU&H streams.
10. The State/UT Counseling authorities shall conduct counseling for admission in 15% of AIQ-PG seats under Private ASU&H colleges/institutes/State Universities (other than Deemed Universities established under the Central Act). Further, State/UT Counseling shall be conducted in adherence to guidelines/schedule provided by NCISM/NCH to avoid the overlapping of the Schedule of AACCC counseling and State/UT counselling
11. In case of 85% of State/UT Quota, the seat matrix for Government Quota, Management Quota, NRI Quota etc., shall be as per respective State and UT policy; however, all admissions in all quotas (except foreign nationals) shall be through online counseling conducted by State/UT counseling authority.
12. Seat allotment in any category shall be as per inter-se-merit.
13. No candidate who has failed to obtain the minimum eligibility marks in AIAPGET – 2024 shall be admitted to Postgraduate courses for the academic year 2024-25.
14. Qualification Criterion: (As per the ASU&H- PG Regulations in force at the time of admission)
 - a) *Indian Medicine Central Council (Post Graduate Ayurveda Education) Amendment Regulations, 2018*
 - b) *Indian Medicine Central Council (Post Graduate Siddha Education) Amendment Regulations, 2018*
 - c) *Indian Medicine Central Council (Post Graduate Unani Medical Education) Amendment Regulations, 2018*
 - d) *Homoeopathy Post-Graduate Degree Course- Doctor of Medicine in Homoeopathy Regulations, 2024*

For admission to ASU&H-PG Courses:

15. Passing marks for eligibility in admission to ASU&H-PG courses should be as per the ASU&H-PG regulations and should be followed strictly. The details of qualifications for different categories are as follows:
 - i. Candidates must possess BAMS/ BUMS/ BSMS/ BHMS/Graded BHMS (after Diploma Course in Homoeopathy of not less than four year's duration)Degree or Provisional degree certificate recognized as per the provisions of the IMCC 1970/HCC 1973/ NCISM 2020 Act /NCH 2020 Act and possess permanent or provisional registration certificate issued by the CCIM/NCISM/CCH/NCH/State Medicine Board, and must have completed a satisfactorily one-year compulsory rotating internship by 31st July 2024 as per the NCISM/NCH notification.(for the academic year 2024-25 only)
 - ii. In order to be eligible for admission to postgraduate courses for an academic year, it shall be necessary for a candidate to obtain minimum of marks at 50th percentile in the All India AYUSH Post Graduate Entrance Test, 2024 (AIAPGET-2024).

Provided that in respect of-

- (a) candidates belonging to the Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes and Other Backward Classes, the minimum marks shall be at 40th percentile;
- (b) candidates with benchmark disabilities specified under the Rights of Persons with Disabilities Act, 2016 (49 of 2016), the minimum marks shall be at 45th percentile for the General Category and 40th percentile for the Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes and Other Backward Classes.
- iii. No upper age limit is specified for admission to ASU&H-PG Courses.
16. No Authority or Institution shall admit any candidate to the Postgraduate courses in contravention of the criteria or procedure in respect of admissions, and any admissions made in contravention shall be cancelled by the NCISM/NCH.
17. Any admissions made beyond/over and above the intake capacity sanctioned/permitted by MARBISM/NCISM/MARBH/NCH/GoI for the said academic session shall not be approved.
18. In compliance of the Court order dated 30.11.2023 in SCA No. 19485/2023 at High Court of Gujarat, it is requested all Central/State/UT counseling Authorities to conduct sufficient phase-wise allotments in stray vacancy round to fill the seats, considering the number of available candidates in the Central/State/UT merit list, whichever is applicable, and availability of vacant seats till that gets filled within the cut-off date of admission as notified by NCISM/NCH. The guidelines for State/UT counseling Authorities to conduct the SVR are as follows:
- Publication of non-reported/not-filled seats after R-3 on the State/UT counseling portal (wide publicity by any other means may also be adopted)
 - Publication of ineligible list of candidates who have not complied with the Central/State/UT counseling rules/norms
 - Registration facility for non-registered candidates on the State/UT counseling portal
 - Choice filling facility, as applicable.
 - Allotment of seats based on merit and preferences of the candidates.
 - Publication of result on the State/UT counseling portal
 - Reporting at the allotted institute
- After the first phase of allotment in SVR, publish the non-reported/not-filled seats on the State/UT counseling portal and conduct subsequent rounds to fill the vacant seats, if any, as per the procedure mentioned in the first phase allotment considering the availability of candidates; however, the whole process of SVR allotment need to be completed within the time frame and no admission after the cut-off date decided by NCISM/NCH shall be allowed/approved.
19. There shall not be any institute-level counseling through any mode. Any admissions made at the institute level shall not be approved by the NCISM/NCH/Concerned University and the institute shall be penalised as per the provision laid down under the sub-section (1)(a)(f) of section 28 of NCISM Act 2020/NCH Act 2020.
20. There shall not be any offline admission or admission without counseling (Central/State/UT), and any admissions in contravention of this shall not be approved.
21. NCISM/NCH shall not approve admissions made without the original documents of the candidates
22. Admission made in violation of the Central Government / NCISM / NCH directives will be treated as invalid, and action will be initiated under the NCISM Act, 2020 / NCH Act, 2020.
21. Institutes will be held responsible in case students face hardship due to admission irregularities such as offline admissions, admission without counseling, and admission beyond sanctioned intake capacity. In such case, students shall be discharged from the course and institution, and the institute will be subjected to face consequences as per the provision laid down under the sub-section (1)(a)(f) of section 28; sub-section (3) of section 10 of NCISM Act 2020/NCH Act 2020, and the person responsible will be prosecuted as per the section of IPC/BNS concerned.

22. Admissions shall not be approved by any means after the cut-off date and time for admission as specified by NCISM/NCH.
23. No authority has the power to extend or modify the cut-off date of admission specified by NCISM/NCH, and such admissions shall not be approved.
24. No authority has the power to modify the intake capacity for admission into PG courses in ASU&H colleges sanctioned by MARBISM/MARBH/NCISM/NCH.
25. State/UT Counseling Authorities may direct ASU&H colleges/institutes to ensure the eligibility of the candidate as laid down in respective relevant IMCC (PG-A/S/U-Education) regulations for Ayurveda, Siddha & Unani for admissions in ASU-PG courses and Homoeopathy Post-Graduate Degree Course-Doctor of Medicine in Homoeopathy Regulations, 2024 for admissions in Homoeopathy-PG courses by proper scrutiny of the relevant original certificates and documents at the time of admission.
26. AACCC, M/o Ayush will circulate the list of ineligible candidates to the State/UT counseling Authority during the 3rd & Stray Vacancy Round (SVR-I & II) of AACCC-PG counseling to prevent them from participating in the State/UT counseling. State/UT Counseling Authorities are requested to ensure that such candidates have not been allotted any seat through any rounds of State/UT counseling for admission in ASU&H-PG courses.
27. ASU&H colleges/institutes should ensure that the candidates, allotted seats through Central/State/UT counseling as the case may be, submit the original Compulsory Rotatory Internship completion certificate at the time of reporting to the allotted institutes. The cut-off date for completion of the internship towards determination of eligibility for appearing in AIAPGET-2024 shall be **31st July 2024** (for A.Y.2024-25 only).
28. State/UT Counseling Authorities may direct ASU&H colleges/institutes to ensure the authenticity and correctness of the details of admitted students before completing the admission procedures. No modifications/ corrections after the cut-off date and time of admission as specified by NCISM/NCH shall be entertained.
29. Central/State/UT Counseling authorities have to submit a list of admitted students (i.e. college-wise consolidated list of admitted students through all rounds of counseling) to NCISM/NCH within 15 working days from the cut-off date of admission in the format and in the manner as prescribed by NCISM/NCH.
30. All State/UT Counseling Authorities are requested to see the website of AACCC, M/o Ayush (<https://aaccc.gov.in>), from time to time for AACCC- PG counseling scheme & FAQs, Schedule and any updates/notices uploaded regarding All India Quota-ASU&H-PG counseling for the A.Y 2024-25.
31. State / UT counseling for ASU&H-PG Courses shall be started only after Central Counseling has commenced, in accordance with the schedule issued by NCISM/NCH.
32. State/UT Counseling Authority shall run an effective **Query Redressal System** to facilitate the counseling and admission process of PG courses and provide the email ID & Phone no of the same on the State/UT Counseling Authority's website
33. **State Ayush Admissions Reporting Portal:** All State/UT counseling Authorities are requested to upload the round-wise data on admissions made through State/UT counseling under 85% of State/UT Quota seats of Govt./Govt. Aided colleges and 100% seats of Private Institutions of Ayurveda, Siddha, Unani and Homoeopathy streams all over the Country on the interphase of the AACCC-PG portal.
- Determination of fees and other charges in case of ASU&H colleges/institutes under NCISM/NCH.-**
34. The fee for 50 percentage (50%) of total sanctioned/permited seats in Private ASU&H medical colleges/institutes and deemed universities which are governed under the NCISM Act, 2020/NCH Act, 2020, is to be determined by Fee fixation/Regulatory Committee (FRC) of the respective State/UT/Deemed University as per the guidelines for "Determination of fee and all other charges" prescribed by NCISM (BUSS/Fee/ASU/2022-23 dated 16-09-2022), and NCH (F.No 1-11/2022/NCH/10322-10331 dated 23.11.2022) which has been implemented from the A.Y 2022-23 onwards.

Tuition fee.-

35. All State/UT Counseling authorities are requested to ensure that the institutes only charge the tuition fee, as laid down and fixed by respective governing or fee fixation committees as applicable, in each academic session. No tuition fee shall be charged for an extended study duration in case of failing examinations or other reasons.

36. All Central/State/UT Counseling authorities are requested to ensure that the college should display tuition fees, hostel fees, and other fees, if any, on the institute's website and the Institute profile while uploading to the Central/State/UT counseling Portal. The same is to be charged from the student at the time of admission. No other charges other than the displayed fees should be charged/collected.

Note: - New PG program structure and Syllabus (will be notify shortly) for Ayurveda, Unani and Siddha shall be applicable from the Academic Year 2024-25.

II. Directives for State/UT counseling for admission in 15% of AIQ-PG seats under Private ASU&H colleges/institutes/Private State Universities (other than Deemed Universities established under the Central Act)

1. The State/UT Counseling authorities shall conduct counseling for 15% of AIQ-PG seats under Private ASU&H colleges/institutes/Private State Universities (other than Deemed Universities established under the Central Act).
2. State/UT Counseling Authorities have to conduct counseling for admission in 15% of AIQ-PG seats under Private ASU&H colleges/institutes/ State Universities (other than Deemed Universities established under Central Act) in adherence with guidelines/schedule provided by NCISM/NCH to avoid the overlapping of the schedule of AACCC counseling and State or UT counseling
3. State/UT counseling authorities shall conduct 2 Rounds of counseling for admission in 15% All India Quota (AIQ) PG seats of Private ASU&H Institutes/Private State Universities (other than Deemed Universities established under the Central Act). The AIQ seats that remain vacant after the second round of State/UT counseling may be converted to the State/UT quota seats, and the same shall be filled up in further rounds as per State Government norms/ rules.
4. State/UT counseling authorities should give wider publicity among AIAPGET-2024 qualified ASU&H-PG aspirants regarding the registration process of counseling & provide sufficient time for registration before each round of counseling for admission in AIQ-PG seats of Private ASU&H Institutes.
5. State/UT may decide on an all-inclusive application Cost/Non-refundable Registration Fee for counseling for admission in ASU&H-PG seats for all category students. **However, the maximum ceiling limit for this fee will be Rs 2000/-.**
6. State/UT may decide on refundable security money, which will be refunded to candidates after joining the allotted college or if the candidate did not get any seat during counseling. **However, the maximum ceiling limit for this fee will be Rs. 50,000/- for PG seats.**
7. The Security money will be forfeited if a candidate does not join the Round-2 allotted seat or surrender/withdraw the seat Round-2 joined seat based on the candidate's request. Further, the Security money will also be forfeited if the Round-2 allotted seat is cancelled due to any unforeseen reason from the candidate's end. For example, the candidate gives wrong information at the time of registration based on which a seat may be allotted and later cancelled by the Admission Authorities at the time of reporting or fails to produce the required original documents at the time of admission (within the stipulated time).
8. Make a provision for candidates admitted in the All India Quota Private (PG) seats during Round 2 of State/UT-PG counseling to withdraw/surrender their admitted seats by forfeiting security money only during a specific time period specified by State/UT authority. Further, State/UT authorities can decide the time period to withdraw/surrender the admitted seat of Round-2 with forfeiture as per their counseling schedule. After the said period, candidates will not be allowed to withdraw/surrender their Round-2 admitted seats. If they do so, they will be ineligible for any further Ayush counseling conducted by Central/State/UT as decided by the State/UT counseling Authorities

9. No domicile certificate is required for allotment of AIQ- PG seats of Private ASU & H Institutes.
10. **Reservation for allotment of 15% AIQ- PG seats in Private ASU&H Institutes:-** all AIQ- PG seats of Private ASU & H Institutes are open in nature (all category candidates are eligible). However, as mentioned in relevant regulations, the relaxation in qualifying criteria may be provided category-wise.
11. For PwD candidates, the PwD certificate should be as per the guidelines issued by Central Government and notified by the NCISM/NCH.
12. State/UT Counseling Authority shall run an effective Query Redressal System to facilitate the counseling and admission process of PG courses and provide email ID & Phone no of the same on the State/UT counseling Authority's website.
13. As per the Central Government Nominated-PG counseling guidelines dated **02.05.2024** for the A. Y 2024-25, issued by the Ministry of Ayush, after the admission process of candidates in the CGN quota, the information regarding vacant seats, if any, shall be forwarded to AACCC, MoA for further necessary action. The AACCC, M/o Ayush will apply Centrally approved reservation roster on the vacant seats as per the extant policy/rules and allot these seats to AIAPGET-2024 qualified candidates based on merit and preference submitted by them on the AACCC-PG portal (<https://aaccc.gov.in>).

Note: - New PG program structure and Syllabus (will be notify shortly) for Ayurveda, Unani and Siddha shall be applicable from the Academic Year 2024-25.

B. DIRECTIVES FOR UNIVERSITIES:

1. In case of admission in Ayurveda, Siddha, Unani, and Homoeopathy courses, the University shall approve the admissions made by any college/institute with proper permission from the MARBISM/MARBH/NCISM/NCH for the academic session 2024-2025.
2. The University shall not approve the admissions made by the colleges/institutes under the following conditions:
- offline admissions
 - admissions without counseling (Central/State/UT);
 - admissions after the cut-off-date,
 - Admissions beyond sanctioned intake capacity.
 - Admissions without original mandatory documents
3. There shall not be any institute-level counseling through any mode. Any admissions made at the institute level shall not be approved by the NCISM/NCH/Concerned University, and the institute shall be penalised as per the provision laid down under sub-section (1)(a)(f) of section 28 of the NCISM Act 2020/NCH Act 2020.

Note: - New PG program structure and Syllabus (will be notify shortly) for Ayurveda, Unani and Siddha shall be applicable from the Academic Year 2024-25.

C. DIRECTIVES FOR COLLEGES/INSTITUTES:

1. No candidate who has failed to obtain the minimum eligibility marks in AIAPGET – 2024 shall be admitted to Postgraduate courses, respectively, for the academic year 2024-25.
2. There shall not be any institute-level counseling through any mode. Any admissions made at the institute level shall not be approved by the NCISM/NCH/Concerned University. Any such admissions made in contravention to the directives/guidelines issued by the NCISM/NCH, the institute shall be penalised as per the provision laid down under the sub-section (1)(a)(f) of section 28 of NCISM Act 2020/NCH Act 2020 .
3. There shall not be any offline admission or admission without counseling (Central/State/UT), or admission beyond sanctioned intake capacity, and any admissions in contravention of this shall not be approved.

4. Admission made in violation of the NCISM / NCH directives will be treated as invalid, and action will be initiated under the NCISM Act,2020/NCH Act, 2020
5. Institutes will be held responsible in case students face hardship due to admission irregularities such as offline admissions, admission without counseling, and admission beyond sanctioned intake capacity etc. In such cases, students shall be discharged from the course and institution. The institute will be subjected to face consequences as per the provision laid down under sub-section (1)(a)(f) of section 28 of NCISM Act 2020/NCH Act 2020. The persons responsible will be prosecuted as per the section of IPC/BNS concerned, whichever is applicable.
6. ASU&H colleges/institutes should ensure the candidate's eligibility as laid down in respective regulations as mentioned in these guidelines and proper scrutiny of the relevant original certificates and documents at the time of admission.
7. It is requested that all participating institutes must visit Central (AACCC-PG portal:<https://aacc.gov.in> and the concerned State/UT counselling portal from time to time for counseling scheme& FAQs, Schedule and any updates/notices regarding PG counseling 2024-25.
8. ASU&H colleges/institutes should ensure the authenticity and correctness of the details of admitted students before completing admission procedures. No modifications/ corrections after the cut-off date and time of admission as specified by NCISM/NCH shall be entertained.
9. The colleges should follow the Central/State/UT counseling schedule and upload the details of admitted students and non-reported/vacant seats, if any, for each round on the concerned counseling authority portal, even on holidays.
10. The list of all admitted students with all details shall be uploaded and submitted to NCISM/NCH in the format prescribed by NCISM/NCH **on or before 6 pm on the cut-off date (05 -12 -2024)** for admission as specified by NCISM/NCH.
11. The college shall display tuition fees, hostel fees, and other fees, if any, on the institute's website and on the Institute profile while uploading on the Central/State/UT counseling portal as applicable. The same is to be charged from the student at the time of admission. No other charges other than the displayed fees should be collected from the candidates
12. To accommodate the maximum number of candidates and minimise the number of non-reported/vacant seats in colleges, the provision of multiple phase allotment in the Stray Vacancy round (*Choice filling is available during SVR-I and no repeated choice filling afterwards*) may be followed by State/UT Ayush counseling authorities.
13. ASU&H colleges/institutes should ensure the eligibility of the candidate as laid down in relevant IMCC-PG-A/S/U-Education regulations for Ayurveda, Siddha & Unani for admissions in PG courses and, Homoeopathy Post-Graduate Degree Course- Doctor of Medicine in Homoeopathy Regulations, 2024 for admissions in Homoeopathy-PG courses by proper scrutiny of the relevant original certificates and documents at the time of admission.
14. ASU&H colleges/institutes should ensure that the candidates, allotted seats through Central/State/UT counseling as the case may be, submit the original Compulsory Rotatory Internship completion certificate at the time of reporting to the allotted institutes otherwise his/her admission shall liable to be cancelled. The cut-off date for completion of the internship towards determination of eligibility for appearing in AIAPGET-2024 shall be **31st July 2024** for the A. Y.2024-25.

Note: - New PG program structure and Syllabus (will be notify shortly) for Ayurveda, Unani and Siddha shall be applicable from the Academic Year 2024-25.

2. The guidelines/schedule for conduction of Central and State/UT Counseling for admission for the academic year 2024-25 will be issued by the NCISM and all counseling authorities are directed to abide by the guidelines and counseling schedule accordingly.

3. All State/UT Counseling Authorities are requested to visit the website of AACCC, Ministry of Ayush (www.aaccc.gov.in), from time to time for updates/notices regarding UG & PG counseling Schedules for the academic year 2024-25.

फा. सं. 4-90/2018 (स्नातकोत्तर विनियम) आयुर्वेद.—भारतीय चिकित्सा केन्द्रीय परिषद्, भारतीय चिकित्सा केन्द्रीय परिषद् अधिनियम, 1970 (1970 का 48) की धारा 36 की उपधारा (1) के खंड (अ), (ज) और (ट) द्वारा प्रदत्त शक्तियों का प्रयोग करते हुए भारतीय चिकित्सा केन्द्रीय परिषद् केन्द्रीय सरकार की पूर्व सहमति से भारतीय चिकित्सा केन्द्रीय परिषद् (स्नातकोत्तर आयुर्वेद शिक्षा) विनियम, 2016 में संशोधन करने हेतु निम्नलिखित विनियमों का निर्माण करती है, अर्थात्—

1. संक्षिप्त भीर्शाक एवं प्रारंभ.—(1) इन विनियमों को भारतीय चिकित्सा केन्द्रीय परिषद् (स्नातकोत्तर आयुर्वेद शिक्षा) (संशोधन) विनियम, 2018 कहा जाएगा।
(2) ये कार्यालय राजपत्र में उनके प्रकाशित होने की तिथि से लागू होंगे।
2. भारतीय चिकित्सा केन्द्रीय परिषद् (स्नातकोत्तर आयुर्वेद शिक्षा) विनियम, 2016 में, विनियम 8 हेतु निम्नलिखित विनियम प्रतिस्थापित होंगे, अर्थात् :-

Regulation (Ayurved).—In exercise of the powers conferred by clauses (i), (j) and (k) of sub-section (1) of section 36 of the Indian Medicine Central Council Act, 1970 (48 of 1970), the Central Council of Indian Medicine, with the previous sanction of the Central Government, hereby makes the following regulations to amend the Indian Medicine Central Council (Post Graduate Ayurveda Education) Regulations, 2016, namely: -

1. Short title and commencement.—(1) These regulations may be called the Indian Medicine Central Council (Post Graduate Ayurveda Education) Amendment Regulations, 2018.

(2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.

2. In the Indian Medicine Central Council (Post Graduate Ayurveda Education) Regulations, 2016, for regulation 8, the following regulation shall be substituted, namely:-

“8. Mode of admission.—(1) A person possessing the degree of Ayurvedacharya (Bachelor of Ayurveda Medicine and Surgery) from a recognised University or Board or medical institution specified in the Second Schedule to the Act and enrolled in Central or State register of Indian System of Medicine shall be eligible for admission in the post-graduate courses.

(2) (i) There shall be a uniform entrance examination to all medical institutions at the post-graduate level namely, the All India AYUSH Post Graduate Entrance Test (AIA-PGET) for admission to post-graduate course in each academic year and shall be conducted by an authority designated by the Central Government:

Provided that the said All India AYUSH Post Graduate Entrance Test (AIA-PGET) shall not be applicable for foreign national's candidates.

(ii) In order to be eligible for admission to post-graduate courses for an academic year, it shall be necessary for a candidate to obtain minimum of marks at 50th percentile in the 'All India AYUSH Post Graduate Entrance Test (AIA-PGET)' held for the said academic year:

Provided that in respect of-

(a) candidates belonging to the Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes and Other Backward Classes, the minimum marks shall be at 40th percentile;

(b) candidates with benchmark disabilities specified under the Rights of Persons with Disabilities Act, 2016 (49 of 2016), the minimum marks shall be at 45th percentile for the General Category and 40th percentile for the Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes and Other Backward Classes.

Explanation.—The percentile shall be determined on the basis of highest marks secured in the all India common merit list in the All India AYUSH Post Graduate Entrance Test (AIA-PGET):

Provided further that when sufficient number of candidates in the respective categories fail to secure minimum marks in the All India AYUSH Post Graduate Entrance Test (AIA-PGET), as specified above, held for any academic year for admission to post-graduate courses, the Central Government in consultation with the Council may at its discretion lower the minimum marks required for admission to post-graduate course for candidates belonging to respective categories and marks so lowered by the Central Government shall be applicable for that academic year only.

(iii) An all India common merit list as well as State-wise merit list of the eligible candidates shall be prepared on the basis of the marks obtained in the All India AYUSH Post Graduate Entrance Test (AIA-PGET) and the candidates, within the respective categories, shall be admitted to post graduate course from the said merit lists only.

(iv) The seat matrix for admission in the Government, Government-aided Institutions and Private Institutions shall be fifteen per cent. for the all India quota and eighty-five per cent. for the States and Union territories quota.

(v) The designated authority for counseling for all admissions to post-graduate course in all Ayurveda educational institutions in the States and Union territories including institutions established by the State Government, University, Deemed University, Trust, Society, Minority Institution, Corporation or Company shall be the respective State or Union territory in accordance with the relevant rules and regulations of the concerned State or Union territory Government, as the case may be.

(vi) The counseling for all admissions to post-graduate course for seats under the all India quota as well as for all Ayurveda educational institutions established by the Central Government shall be conducted by the authority designated by the Central Government.

(vii) No candidate who has failed to obtain the minimum eligibility marks as specified above shall be admitted to post-graduate course in the said academic year.

(viii) No authority or institution shall admit any candidate to the post-graduate course in contravention of the criteria or procedure as laid down by these regulations in respect of admissions and any candidate admitted in contravention of the said criteria or procedure shall be discharged by the Council forthwith.

(ix) The authority or institution which grants admission to any student in contravention of the aforesaid criteria or procedure shall be liable to face action in terms of the provisions of the Act.

(3) The sponsored candidates shall also be required to possess the percentile of marks specified in clause (ii) of sub-regulation (2).

(4) Change of subject shall be permissible within a period of two months from the date of admission, subject to availability of vacancy and guide in the concerned department.”.

- (2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.

2. In the Homoeopathy (Post Graduate Degree Course) M.D. (Hom.) Regulations, 1989, in regulation 4, for sub-regulation (2), the following sub-regulation shall be substituted, namely:-

“(2) (i) There shall be a uniform entrance examination to all medical institutions at the postgraduate level namely, the All India AYUSH Post Graduate Entrance Test (AIA-PGET) in each academic year and shall be conducted by an authority designated by the Central Government:

Provided that the said All India AYUSH Post Graduate Entrance Test (AIA-PGET) shall not be applicable for foreign national’s candidates.

(ii) In order to be eligible for admission to postgraduate course for an academic year, it shall be necessary for a candidate to obtain minimum of marks at 50th percentile in the ‘All India AYUSH Post Graduate Entrance Test (AIA-PGET)’ held for the said academic year:

Provided that in respect of-

- (a) candidates belonging to the Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes and Other Backward Classes, the minimum marks shall be at 40th percentile;

(vii) No candidate who has failed to obtain the minimum eligibility marks as specified above shall be admitted to postgraduate course in the said academic year.

(viii) No authority or institution shall admit any candidate to the postgraduate course in contravention of the criteria or procedure as laid down by these regulations in respect of admissions and any candidate admitted in contravention of the said criteria or procedure shall be discharged by the Central Council forthwith.

(ix) The authority or institution which grants admission to any student in contravention of the aforesaid criteria or procedure shall be liable to face action in terms of the provisions of the Act.”.

I am directed to invite your attention to the Punjab Government Circular Letter No.1/3/95-3PP II/2043, dated 29/1/1996 vide which the instructions were issued regarding simplification of procedure for obtaining the certificate of Domicile for purposes of admission to educational institutions (including technical/medical institution). The matter has been reconsidered in the light of judgement delivered by the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in the case of Dr. Pradeep Jain Vs. Union of India and others reported as AIR 1984-SC-4121 wherein it was held that instead of the word 'Domicile' the word 'Residence' be used in the instructions issued by the State Government on the subject. Accordingly, it has been decided by the Government to revise the Government instructions referred to above as under:

With reference to letter No.1/3/95-3PII/9619, dated the 6th June, 1996 of this Department on the subject noted above and to say that keeping in view the hardship being faced by the Employees in getting the 'Residence Certificate' it has been decided to decentralize the powers of issuing the 'Residence Certificate' in process of the categories mentioned below:-

- a) The employees of Punjab Government posted in or outside Punjab State or working on deputation having at least 3 years of service.
- b) the employees of Government of India posted in Chandigarh or in Punjab in connection with the affairs of the Punjab Government for a period of 3 years.
- c) the employees of State Government institutions/undertaking who are posted in Chandigarh or in Punjab in connection with the affairs of the Punjab Government for a period of 3 years.
- d) the employees having at least 3 years of service in autonomous bodies/companies in which Punjab Government has 20% or more shares.

The Heads of the office shall be competent to issue the requisite certificate to the employees with the exception that in the case of head of Office, the Head of the Department shall be the Competent Authority to issue the certificate

From: Chief Secretary to Government of Punjab to all the Heads of the department etc.
Subject: Issuance of certificate for the purpose of seeking admission to various educational/technical/professional institutions in the state and also for employment.

Sir,

It has been brought to the notice of Government that educational authorities and institutions prescribe various certificates regarding residence, SC/BC category and backward area etc. to be furnished by the students/candidates with the applications forms for entrance examinations or employment in the formats and by the authorities different from those prescribed by the Government departments. Cases have also been reported where the authorities concerned insist on retaining original certificates and refuse to accept the attested photo copies of the certificates. All this results in harassment and panic among the students/candidates and their parents/guardian, since they have to apply with such certificates to more than one authorities simultaneously and within a limited period. The lists of certificates required at the time of applying for CET/PMET/PMT and PAU are enclosed by way of illustration.

2. In order to overcome the difficulty mentioned above, it has been decided by the Government that following procedure has been decided by the Government that the following procedure shall be followed meticulously by all the educational and other authorities concerned:-

- i) Certificates issued in the format and by the authorities prescribed by the Government Departments shall be accepted as valid by all educational institutions and other authorities.
- ii) Where a number of authorities have been authorized to issue the certificates there shall be no insistence on issue of a certificate by any particular authority or by the highest authority indicated in the format.
- iii)(a) In case of entrance examinations, no certificate should be called for in the first instance alongwith the application form. It will be sufficient for the candidate seeking admission or other facility to indicate in the application from whether he/she belongs to any particular category entitled him/her to certain concessions or facility. Requisite certificates may be obtained only from the selected/wait listed candidates.
- iii)(b) To further simplify the procedure attested copies of the certificates only shall be retained and original certificates if required to be produced at the time of interview shall be returned immediately, thereafter.
- iv) Parents/guardian or candidates can also obtain SC certificates from the Head of the institution where the candidates has studied if the proof is available in the school records.
- v) The persons who are employed in Government of India or any other State Government are to be treated at par with the employees of the Government of Punjab in the matter of issue of Scheduled Caste certificate provided relevant Scheduled Caste certificate exists in their service record. The Scheduled Caste certificate in such will be issued by the respective Heads of Departments in the Proforma below:-


